

### TheRide Your Way: Continuing to Improve the Ways You Connect



Hello,

I'm Matt Carpenter, TheRide's new CEO. It is a pleasure to be serving such a great community and to be a member of TheRide's exceptional team. I bring with me over 15 years of professional experience in the transit industry, including eight as the CEO of Strathcona County Transit in Sherwood Park, Alberta, Canada. While I'm proud of the work I contributed there, it's good to be back in Michigan. Previously, I worked for the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) in Detroit, and I hold a Master's degree in Urban Planning from the University of Michigan. I've helped communities plan and implement major transit improvements; such as bus network expansions, paratransit reforms, rapid transit studies, and double-decker buses. I believe that providing exceptional customer service, being reliable stewards of the public trust, and working together as a team are essential in achieving goals and effectively serving our community.

Last August, TheRide began implementing its Five-Year Transit Improvement Program (FYTIP), and this August, those efforts will continue to provide you with more ways to connect with jobs, schools, medical appointments, shopping, and each other. You will soon be able to try our later weekend service on 17 routes, new Sunday service in Ypsilanti on three routes, and a brand new route; 67 Platt–Michigan Avenue, which connects riders with Meijer on Carpenter Rd. and Walmart in Saline. Our A-Ride service for seniors and persons with disabilities will have later service on weekends and our NightRide service will see changes to its service hours.

As we continue to provide new and expanded service to the urban core of Washtenaw County, we are also making plans to improve the Ypsilanti Transit Center (YTC). The YTC currently serves more than 3,000 riders on an average weekday. Working with the City of Ypsilanti, Eastern Michigan University and other community leaders, TheRide will be working to improve the experience at the YTC and will be taking into account accessibility, rider amenities/comfort, sign/technology improvements, and environmental improvements.

In order to get all these new services on the street and to continue providing safe, reliable service, we have ordered 18 new buses. Starting this month, you'll begin to see a new bus design emerge, which is a reflection of TheRide's commitment to adapt to the evolving and growing needs of our vibrant community.

Thank you for welcoming me, I'm proud to have been selected to be a part of the exciting work being done here. I'm looking forward to focusing my passion for transit and the greater Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti areas as I begin my work with a team that is dedicated towards providing reliable and accessible transportation options for each of you each day.

### Accessible Services

RideCorp (a subsidiary of Blue Cab Inc.) began delivery of paratransit services for the Ann Arbor Area Transportation Authority May 1, 2015.

A-Ride is a shared-ride transportation service for individuals who are prevented from using TheRide fixed-route bus service due to a disability. You must have a TheRide-issued A-Ride card to use A-Ride services. To request an A-Ride Card Application, please fill out the online request, print an application, or call 734-973-6500. Professional certification of a disability is required as part of the application process.

### New Artwork at Blake Transit Center





TheRide received submissions from 19 artists in response to its call for artwork for the new facility, as part of the transit center's rebuild project. Following a competitive review process and public input period in January, 2014, Los Angeles artist Roberto Delgado was chosen as the finalist. Delgado's work for TheRide is titled *Ann Arbor History and Culture*, and chronicles the culture and history of Ann Arbor through contemporary and historical photos that are incorporated into a unique cut tile with airbrush over photo-silkscreen medium.

In describing his artistic approach, Roberto Delgado said:

"My work evolves from the reality of the photo. Both the easel work and public art murals have been based on the people and circumstances that I encounter, with both being an appreciation of the human figure."


