Trotwood, Ohio, August 20, 2019 - The Greater Dayton Realtist Association is announcing a Press Conference on Wednesday, September 11, 2019, 11:00 a.m. at the City of Trotwood Office Building, 3035 Olive Road, Trotwood, Ohio 45426 to present a monetary donation to the Trotwood Disaster Relief Fund.

We have been joined in our continual rebuilding efforts by the Ohio Realtist Association, the Greater Cincinnati Realtist Association and the generous mortgage forgiving actions of Union Savings Bank. Trotwood was one of the cities in our immediate service area that suffered massive devastation from the Memorial Day tornados.
