Thank you for expressing an interest in the Post 403 American Legion "Fifth Grade Flag Essay Contest". The purpose of the contest is to develop a more profound knowledge and appreciation for the United States Flag on the part of elementary-aged students. Additional objectives include the ability to gain an understanding of flag etiquette and respect for the flag. Eligible participants must be citizens residing in Iowa and enrollment in the firth grade in a public, parochial, military, private, or state-accredited home school.

Essay Format

The format for the essay is limited to the following:

- A one (1) page document
- Contain 300 words or less
- Double-spaced
- 12-point font
- The student's own words and effort

The nine District entries will then be submitted to the America Legion Department of Iowa Children & Youth Committee for judging at the Iowa American Legion Department Mid-Winter Conference in February. Department First, Second, and Third Place winners will also receive \$500, \$300, and 200 from the American Legion of Iowa and American Legion Foundation.
