Selection Criteria

The Hana Lima Scholarship is a competitive vocational education scholarship given to non-traditional students: single parents, sole-income providers, previously incarcerated, wards of the court, houseless/homeless, or someone with a disabled (meets ADA definition)*. Students that are current dependents of a non-traditional parent/legal guardian may also qualify under these guidelines.

Students pursuing a major in Liberal Arts do not qualify for this award as this scholarship supports students who have declared and are committed to a specific program of study.

*Scholarship offerings are subject to availability of funds.

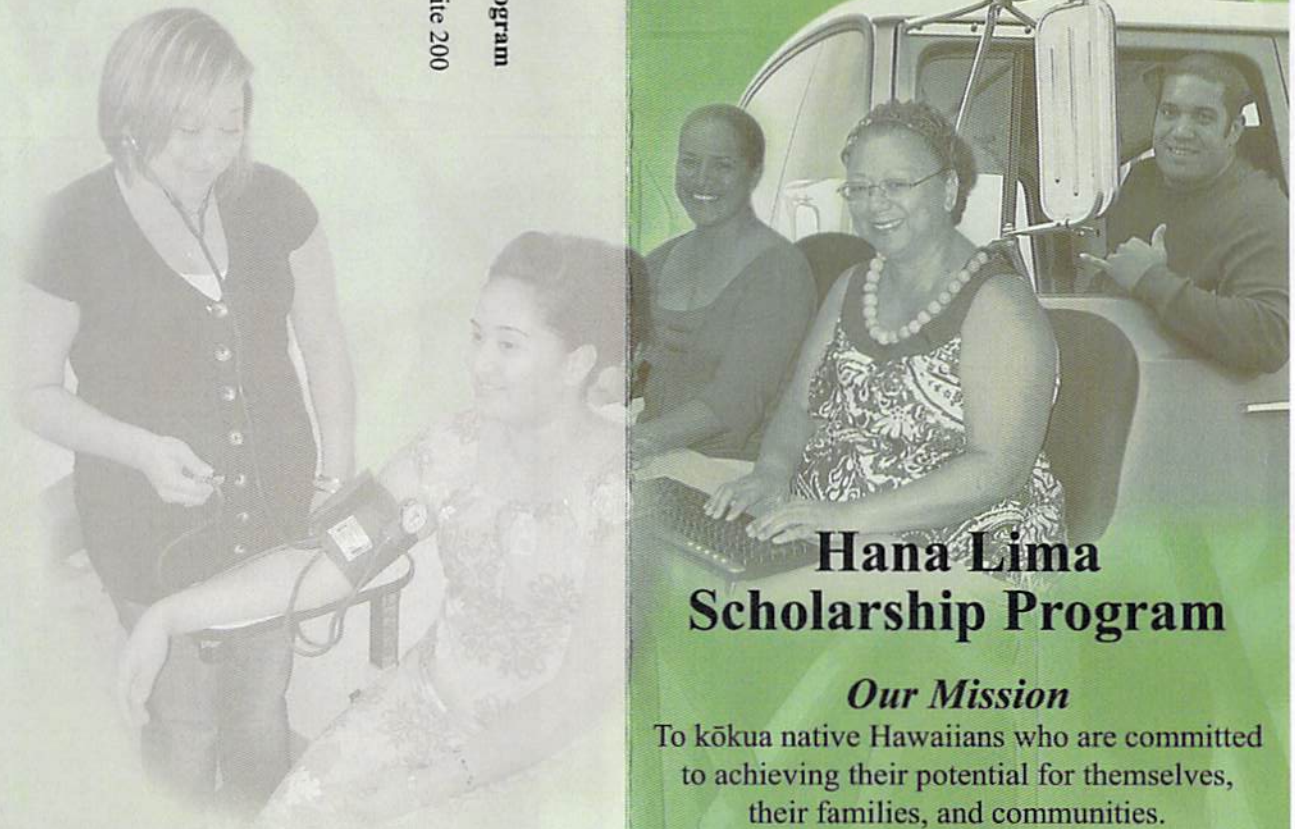

Purpose

The purpose of the Hana Lima Scholarship is to give financial assistance to students participating in a vocational or technical education program for occupations that can provide a “living wage”. Eligible programs include Certificate and Associate’s Degree programs within a specific segment of employment. This \$1,500 scholarship gives financial assistance for tuition, books, required tools and uniforms for a vocational program.

Eligibility

As an applicant, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be of Native Hawaiian ancestry
 - Be a resident of the state of Hawai‘i
 - Received a High School Diploma or equivalent
 - Not currently receiving any Kamehameha Schools financial aid for post-secondary education
 - Maintain a 2.0 or higher grade point average (GPA)
 - Be enrolled at least half-time in a vocational degree or certification program at one of the educational institutions in Hawai‘i listed on the application
 - Be a non-traditional student: single parent, sole-income provider, previously incarcerated, ward of the court, houseless/homeless or someone with a disability
- OR
- Be a dependent of a parent who is a part of a non-traditional household: parent is a single parent, sole-income provider, previously incarcerated, houseless/homeless or someone with a disability
