The Waldron landscape crew, headed by Rafael Casillas, did a great job. Removing stumps and roots, replacing soil and checking the irrigation was done prior to planting. Next time you are out and about check out the new look.

For the remainder of the year we will focus on maintenance with new projects delayed until 2019.

The backflow installation is completed and Ben and I were very pleased with the care that Valley Of the Moon showed in disturbing our existing lawn and trees as little as possible.
