JUDGING CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

FLOAT - BUSINESS/COMMERCIAL

 a wagon pulled by a vehicle or tractor and trailer, representing a business or commercial cause

FLOAT - CIVIC

- with members under the age of 18, a wagon pulled by a vehicle or tractor and trailer, representing a group and not a business
- with members over the age of 19, a wagon pulled by a vehicle or tractor and trailer, representing a group and not a business

SCHOOL/DAYCARE FLOAT

- a wagon pulled by a vehicle, or tractor and trailer, representing a school, class, or daycare MARCHING UNIT
 - under the age of 18MUST have 10 or more members and all members
 - over the age of 19MUST have 10 or more members and all members

EQUESTRIAN

- Equestrian which may include in that category horse, donkey, llama. <u>MUST HAVE SCOOPER</u>. ANTIQUE VEHICLE
 - a vehicle at least 20 years old

THEME-DECORATED VEHICLE

- a vehicle decorated to the theme, fall foliage, flowers, lights, music, no groups COSTUMED CHARACTER(S)
 - 1 (one) person (with supervision if under age 18) in costume and not using motorized vehicle
 - 2 (two) or more persons (with supervision if under age 18) in costume and not using a motorized vehicle

DIGNITARY (POLITICAL/QUEEN)

- person(s) representing a candidate, office, or officer/leader of an organization or contest winner
- MUST BE THEME-ORIENTED OR HAVE FLOWERS OR FALL FOLIAGE VISIBLE TO SPECTATORS-THIS CATEGORY IS NOT JUDGED
