

The Ralston City Council met in a regular session on Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. at Ralston City Hall. Roll was called with the following present: Konwinski, Fideline, Alberhasky, Krause, Sanchez, & Preis. Groesser was absent. The agenda for this meeting was available at City Hall for public inspection and posted prior to the meeting. The legal notice for the meeting was published in the Ralston Recorder. Claims listed are approved and a part of these minutes.

Krause gave the Acknowledgement of Open Meeting Law Posting.

It was moved to approve the Consent Agenda, with the exception of the Maria’s Restaurant claim listed, by Konwinski, seconded by Preis. Fideline abstains, the rest of Council votes yes, motion carries. It was moved to approve the Maria’s claim by Konwinski, seconded by Preis. Sanchez abstains, all others vote yes, motion carries.

Costanzo reported that the Keno gross revenue was \$120,000. Costanzo stated that effective March 1 the charges from Papillion Sanitation will reflect a cost decrease in diesel prices and a cost increase for landfill fees, so the savings per household will be 13 cents. Benis said the Night Ranger Concert is sold out, KAT Radio is giving away 800 tickets to Future Faces of Country that will be in the Wiebe Banquet Hall, and Merle Haggard is at about 1600 tickets sold. Benis said the Omaha Dancing with the Stars has sold out the 75 floor tables; there are still bowl tickets available, and reminded all that the Mayor is dancing in it. Benis reported on the Baxter Roundball Series, with a little over 3,300 people in attendance, and reported on upcoming events.

Consideration of Brian Kavanaugh to the Library Board of Trustees was moved for approval by Konwinski, seconded by Preis. Kavanaugh introduced himself to Council. All vote yes, motion carries.

Council Comments: Krause commented on how important it is to see a doctor as soon as possible if you think you have the flu.

There being nothing further of a general nature to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 7:07 PM.
