At Forensic Psychology Associates (FPA), we follow the current CDC recommendations for the safety of our staff and clientele.

1. Staff are required to wear masks when interacting with each other and our visitors.
2. For outpatient visitors to our office:
 - a. All visitors are required to wear a mask.
 - b. Visitors who have received their final vaccination at least two weeks before their appointment can choose to be interviewed in the same room as the doctor, with all parties wearing masks. Or they can choose the video procedure outlined below.
 - c. For visitors who have not been vaccinated, we have an in-house video arrangement from office-to-office. After an in-person greeting, the visitor will be in one room and the doctor will be in another for a video-linked interview. Once you are alone in the video room you may remove your mask. Specialized psychological testing will take place in-person as needed, with all parties wearing masks.
 - d. Some outpatients may be appropriate for video evaluations from home.
3. For criminal defendants who are in custody: we adhere to the safety protocols of the jails and detention centers. Many

professional visits are by video; some are in-person in a non-contact booth; full-contact visits are only by special arrangement and when necessary to complete a valid assessment.

These guidelines are subject to change as the science about the pandemic evolves and for exceptional circumstances.
