Dora Clara DeSloover, 83, of Caseville died Tuesday morning, Nov. 28, 2000, at Sunny Acres Nursing Center. She was born March 13, 1917, at the home of her parents, Adolf and Clara (Schlag) Geber in France. On Feb. 25, 1950, she was united in marriage to August DeSloover in Waiblingen, Germany. They moved to Detroit and then to Caseville later that year. He preceded her in death on Aug. 25, 1977. Mrs. DeSloover owned and operated Dora's Beauty Shop in Caseville for almost 45 years, retiring in the early 1990s. She was a faithful member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Caseville.
