ORDINANCE NO. 406

An Ordinance Repealing City of Rolla Ordinance No. 400 and Reenacting Section 15 of Ordinance No. 317 Regulating The Sale Of Alcoholic Beverages In The City Of Rolla, North Dakota.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolla, That Ordinance No. 400 be repealed and that Section 15 Time Of Sale, of Ordinance No. 317, Alcoholic Beverages, be reenacted to read as follows:

"Section 15, Time Of Sale.

No licensee shall serve, sell or permit to be sold or served or consumed on the licensed premises, any alcoholic beverages, after one a.m. and before twelve noon on Sundays, or between the hours of one a.m. and eight a.m. on all other days of the week, or on Christmas Day or after six p.m. on Christmas Eve. In addition, a person may not provide off sale after one a.m. on Thanksgiving Day, At no time may alcoholic beverages be sold, served or consumed on any licensed premises in violation of North Dakota law. The specialty restaurant license is taken care of in Section 6(f) of Ordinance No. 317, therefore the provision in this section will not apply to the specialty restaurant license."

This Ordinance shall take affect immediately after its Final Passage: First Reading: February 20, 2008
