

CARD MINISTRY

UPKEEP COMMITTEE

The Upkeep Committee is responsible for the general care and improvement of the church campus that includes the church building, Faith Hall (fellowship hall), manse (pastor's residence) and the Puckety Church Cemetery that is located approximately a quarter of a mile farther down Puckety Church Road. Upkeep maintains all areas of the campus by repairing and improving the facilities when it is with in our skill set to do so. Jobs that are beyond our ability are bid out for repair. Our biggest ongoing responsibility is for lawn and landscape care. This runs as a major focus from April until November of each year. We have rotating mowing teams to service the church grounds and the cemetery. We also maintain services for snow and ice removal. We oversee the church custodial services and housekeeper services. Utility services are part of our responsibilities.

CEMETERY COMMITTEE

The Cemetery Committee is a small separate administrative committee that oversees cemetery care, plot sales and internments. This committee operates in close cooperation with the Upkeep Committee in its every day operations.

MEMORIAL FUND COMMITTEE

The Memorial Committee is a small committee that is responsible for overseeing the collection and expenditures of donations made to the church in honor and memory of deceased persons. The committee determines what are worthy expenditures following the strict guidelines established for the use of this money.

OUTREACH TEAM

We are in flux right now. We are in the process of determining what our focus will be as a church. We do have plenty of opportunities that some of us are starting to do to help others in our community through the Compassion Network, a group of members from local churches. PUCKETY CHURCH CHOIR

The adult choir of Puckety Church has long been respected in the area as being a wonderful choir. The choir meets Thursday evenings from 6:30-8:00 pm in the church, from about mid-September to last Sunday before Memorial Day. Some of our singers are trained musicians and some have had no prior choral singing experience. We all help each other! There is no audition process. We sing a variety of styles of music, from contemporary to traditional, and all the while holding onto foremost that God is our focus and our praise is for him alone. And still we have plenty of time for laughter and friendship! We thank God for the dedicated members and musicians who currently attend rehearsals and Sunday services. FELLOWSHIP AND CARE TEAM

Fellowship and Care demonstrates communal care of our congregation and community. We, as a team of believers, have the ability to serve the congregation and community by becoming a family of God through servitude. Our mission is to help our congregation be the body of Christ for each other through fellowship and care. We can accomplish this with coffee hours after service, pot luck dinners, picnics and social events. This team plans and carries out these events held at the church several times per year as well as a monthly coffee hour following worship. PULPIT ASSISTANT VOLUNTEERS GROUP

The Pulpit Assistants help lead the worship service, along with the pastor. Normally, the Pulpit Assistant introduces and leads the following parts of worship: The Welcome & Announcements, Call to Worship, Prayer of Confession, Assurance of Forgiveness, and First Scripture Reading. The information as to what the Pulpit Assistant says and does is sent out from the church office several days before the Sunday worship service. Anyone who can speak clearly and confidently, using the microphone, is welcome to volunteer. FUNERAL LUNCH VOLUNTEERS GROUP

Our group of men and women work very hard to be sure the lunches we provide are stress free for the family. We contact the family and give our condolence and determine the number for the lunch. We then go shopping for the food. Our people are called and scheduled to help prepare the food, set up the room, and clean up after the meal. We greet everyone as they come in for lunch and make them feel welcome. A lot of fellowship is had by all. This is an extension of the Deacon's outreach.

WORSHIP TEAM

The worship team is responsible for the music, videos and focus of worship each Sunday. We work together with the pastor to plan a worship service which provides a variety of ways to glorify God. We responsible to find both pulpit supply (a pastor who leads worship) when the pastor is unavailable and either a substitute organist if the organist is off, or we work with the pastor and the praise band leader to ensure the music for the service is covered. PRAISE BAND

The praise band is part of the worship Team. Members share their God given musical talents by playing an instrument in the band, singing, or making a joyful noise to God through music. AV VOLUNTEERS

The AV Team is part of the Worship Team. Members of this team rotate Sundays, to create the slides (with backgrounds and words to songs, scriptures, prayers, etc) that are used on teh screen during worship. A program called Media Shout is used, and training on the current computer system is provided. Using the bulletin which the secretary emails, you can work on creating the slides either at home or at the church before Sunday morning. (If done at home, you would need software on your computer to remotely log into the church computer). You are able to sit in the sound room for a week or two and observe, if you'd like to learn more or aren't sure this is something you want to do. If you enjoy creating a visual worship to share with the congregation, this is the team for you. If you are interested and want to know more, please contact John Fisher.

DISCIPLESHIP TEAM

We envision a culture where we answer God's call to become and make disciples. We accomplish this through life-long biblical study and practice to grow closer to Jesus Christ.
