John 14:1-6: Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it were* not *so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also.

4 And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

5 Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Revelation 21:21 - And the twelve gates *were* twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city *was* pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

It has been said, that which men set their hearts on down here will be that which they set their feet on in heaven (gold). Keep looking at the Saviour, who, for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of God the Father. Consider him who endured such contradiction of sinners against himself and the fact that you will look him in the eye someday and give an account of how you faired down here on earth. We have not resisted unto blood striving against sin. We have it pretty easy in America, so rather than look at our problems, we ought to rejoice and give thanks for Jesus is coming soon!
