Instructions for Circulation of Nomination Papers

Signatures of Electors: Only qualified electors of the State of Wisconsin (at least 18 years old by date of signing, U.S. citizens who are full-time residents of the 21st Senate District) may sign nomination papers. Each elector signing a nomination paper must list all of the information required. Each elector's municipality of residence must be listed on the nomination paper along with the address, including any street name and number, rural route number, and/or fire number. Post office boxes are not valid. The circulator may add any missing or illegible information before the papers are filed with the filing officer.

Signature of Circulator: The circulator should carefully read the language of the Certification of Circulator. The circulator must personally present the nomination paper to each signer. The nomination paper may not be left unattended on counters or posted on bulletin boards. The circulator's complete residential address, including municipality of residence, must be listed in the certification. After obtaining signatures of electors, the circulator must sign and date the certification.


