

HOW TO MAKE AN ONLINE RESERVATION FOR A HORSE CAMPGROUND SITE

To make reservations for state horse campgrounds in Wisconsin, go to Wisconsin.goingtocamp.com. This is what comes up.

See the “Equestrian” tab in the center? You need to click on that to make reservations at any state owned horse campground.

When you click on the Equestrian tab, under “Park”, only the state campgrounds in Wisconsin will be listed. These are the state parks that have horse campgrounds. They are as follows:

- Governor Dodge State Park
- Governor Knowles State Forest
- Kettle Moraine State Forest - Northern Unit
- Kettle Moraine State Forest - Southern Unit
- Wildcat Mountain State Park

Select the park you want. Then you need to fill in the rest of the information asked for on this page before you hit the “Search” button.

Kettle Moraine State Forest - Southern Unit

Covering more than 22,000 acres of forested glacial hills, kettle lakes and prairies, the Southern Unit of the Kettle Moraine is interlaced with more than 100 miles of mountain biking, horseback riding and hiking and nature trails. Paddling, boating, swimming, fishing, hunting and winter sport opportunities are all available. There are three family campgrounds (Ottawa Lake, Pinewoods, Whitewater Lake), a horseriders camp, two group camps, and remote backpack shelters.

When you click on the Horseriders green dot, this will come up. It shows all the horse campsites at Horseriders Campground in Map View. You can also see the sites in List View or Calendar View. Check out each view to see what they show.

Kettle Moraine State Forest - Southern Unit

Covering more than 22,000 acres of forested glacial hills, kettle lakes and prairies, the Southern Unit of the Kettle Moraine is interlaced with more than 100 miles of mountain biking, horseback riding and hiking and nature trails. If you want to know if a site has a corral and/or pen, you can click the List View. Select the site you want, then select the Details button and it will show all the amenities at that site. Horse Corral is listed on the far right bottom and it will say Yes or No. At this time, it won't tell you if the site has one or two corrals. You will need to reference the maps on our website to know which sites have one or two corrals.

All sites are reservable except 468, 469 and 470. These three sites are available on a first-come, first serve basis.

All reservable sites need to be reserved at least 2 days before occupancy. There is a two night minimum stay if booked prior to May 15 for stays between May 15 and October 31. Holiday weekends require a three night minimum stay. There is a \$7.75 online reservation fee and a \$5.00 cancellation/change fee. Rates for each site and time of year vary, so you will need to check the rates on the website.
