PERSONALLY CAME AND APPEARED:

GLENN M. HUTCHINSON, whose signature is hereunto subscribed, being all of the full age of majority and under no legal impediment, who declared that, availing himself of the provisions of the Louisiana Non-Profit Corporation Law (Title 12, Chapter 2, Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950), he does hereby organize a non-profit corporation as defined in Sections 201 (7) of Title 12, Chapter 2, Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 under and in accordance with these articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be:

CAJUN CORVETTE CLUB, INC.

herein referred to as C.C.C.

ARTICLE II

C.C.C. shall be a non-profit Corporation as is defined in RS 12:201(7). No informality herein shall have the effect of rendering these Articles of Incorporation null and void nor of exposing any member to any liability or responsibility.

No member of C.C.C. shall ever be personally liable or responsible for any obligation, default, debt or liability of C.C.C., beyond the amount of his unpaid and past due dues.

ARTICLE III

SECTION A. MEMBERSHIP

C.C.C. is organized for the following purposes and to carry on the following purposes:

- 1. To bring together those persons who are interested in

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- Corvette sports cars.
2. To encourage the preservation, ownership, and operation of Corvette sports cars through membership in the National Council of Corvette Clubs herein referred to as N.C.C.C.
 3. To act as a source of technical and other information useful or interesting to Corvette owners.
 4. To promote the sport of motoring.
 5. To advance the causes of skillful and safe driving.
 6. To sponsor, promote, and sanction sports car events and social activities among the members and other enthusiasts.

SECTION B. CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

The membership of C.C.C. shall consist of five categories as follows:

1. Owner Members: Corvette owners who are members of the N.C.C.C. and their spouses.
2. Associate Members: Corvette owners who are not members of N.C.C.C., their spouses, and non-Corvette owners and their spouses.
3. Member-At-Large: Those persons who qualify as Owner Members, but who live one hundred (100) or more miles from C.C.C. domicile.
4. Dealer Members: Authorized Chevrolet dealers who share the interest of C.C.C.
5. Honorary Member: Those persons whose interest in, support of, or contribution to C.C.C. merit such recognition.

SECTION C. PRIVILEGES

1. Owner Members are entitled to full rights in C.C.C.
2. Associate Members are entitled to same C.C.C. except the right to vote on N.C.C.C. issues and the right to hold executive offices.
3. Honorary Members, Dealer Members, and Member-at-Large are entitled to all rights in C.C.C. except the right to vote and hold office in C.C.C.

SECTION D. DUES, EXPULSION, AND RESIGNATION

The by-laws shall set forth the procedure for the resigning membership, the amount of dues and the method of collection, and the fiscal year of C.C.C. The by-laws shall also set forth the grounds

and methods for cancellation or suspension of membership, provided the by-laws also provide policy for the reinstatement of members expelled or suspended.

ARTICLE VI.

The registered office of C.C.C. shall be:

ARTICLE VII.

Club officers and their duties:

The executive officers of C.C.C. shall be president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, and N.C.C.C. governor, each of whose qualifications, duties, powers, terms of office, method and time of election, and installation will be set forth in the by-laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

SECTION A. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporate powers and management of C.C.C. shall be vested in and exercised by a board of directors which shall consist of the officers set forth in Article VII, and such additional members as shall be set forth in the by-laws provided the board shall number not less than three members nor more than eleven to be elected annually at a general meeting of the members to be held in accordance with the by-laws at the registered office of C.C.C., or a such time or place within the State of Louisiana as may be provided in the by-laws.

SECTION C. SUCCESSION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEMBERSHIP

Any vacancy in the board of directors shall be filled by election of the membership according to the by-laws.

Failure to elect directors annually or to fill a vacancy shall not dissolve C.C.C. nor impair its Corporate existence or management, but the directors then in office shall remain until their successors have been duly elected and installed.

SECTION D. MEETINGS

The Board shall have meetings at specified places and times as they may appoint. The procedure for notice of such meeting shall be set forth in the by-laws.

The number of persons constituting a quorum, either in person or by proxy, both for directors and membership meetings, shall be set forth in the by-laws.

ARTICLE IX.

The board of directors shall have the power to make, amend, and repeal by-laws to govern C.C.C. provided they are in accordance with and do not conflict with these articles, and are approved by a two-thirds vote of the voting members attending a meeting called for that purpose.
