Qualifications:

- ☐ Must be a permanent Illinois resident
- ☐ Grade point average of 2.0 or higher
- $\ \square$ Upon completion of first year of college, the scholarship recipient may be asked to return to his/her school and speak to a designated group of students regarding his/her experience. The Russell Brian Gusloff Foundation hopes this will encourage younger students to think seriously about attending college themselves.

Each individual submitting a recommendation must certify that he or she is not the applicant's relative, not an employee of someone related to the applicant, and not affiliated with the school that the applicant is planning to attend.
