**RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING THE POSITION OF
SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS OF THE TOWN OF HAMPTON TO RESIDE
OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF HAMPTON,
WASHINGTON COUNTY, NEW YORK**

WHEREAS, the Town Board (the “Town Board”) of the Town of Hampton (the “Town”) has seen an inability to obtain residents of the Town of Hampton as candidates for the office of superintendent of highways of the Town of Hampton and wishes to permit and authorize any individual to hold the office of superintendent of highways of the Town of Hampton who resides within the corporate limits of the Town, or within the corporate limits of a town within Washington County, New York that immediately adjoins the corporate limits of the Town; and

WHEREAS, in order to permit same, the Town Board must consider a proposed local law authorizing any individual to hold the office of superintendent of highways of the Town of Hampton who resides within the corporate limits of the Town, or within the corporate limits of a town within Washington County, New York that immediately adjoins the corporate limits of the Town; and

WHEREAS, a proposed local law authorizing same has been drafted and is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to hold a public hearing concerning the proposed local law authorizing any individual to hold the office of superintendent of highways of the Town of Hampton who resides within the corporate limits of the Town, or within the corporate limits of a town within Washington County, New York that immediately adjoins the corporate limits of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the proposed local law authorizing any individual to hold the office of superintendent of highways of the Town of Hampton who resides within the corporate limits of the Town, or within the corporate limits of a town within Washington County, New York that

immediately adjoins the corporate limits of the Town, is hereby accepted for introduction to the Town Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a public hearing shall be scheduled for the consideration of this proposed local law to be held by the Town Board April 15, 2021 at 7:00 pm at the Town offices; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is direct to post and publish a notice of said public hearing in the *Granville Sentinel and the Whitehall Times* at least five (5) days before the hearing.
