HALLOWEEN CHARACTER PARADE COSTUME GUIDELINES

Are you getting ready for our annual school parade to be held on Wednesday, Oct 31?
As you plan your costume, please refer to the Costume Guidelines below. Thank you.

1. Students may not wear masks.
2. No costumes that promote any type of violence (ie: weapons, guns, swords, make-up portraying gore, etc.)
3. No revealing costumes of any nature. Please make sure costumes are age-appropriate. Leggings are required for costumes that are above the knee. No fish net or see-through tights will be allowed.
4. No high heel shoes.
5. Sleeveless or spaghetti strap tops must be worn with a shirt underneath or sweater over it.
6. If you have questions regarding a costume, bring the costume to school before the day of the parade so the teacher can approve it.

Any costume that portrays anything against the Catholic teachings will not be allowed. If a student does not follow these guidelines they will be asked to call home in order to obtain their school uniform.

Please remember that dressing up for Halloween is a privilege, so we ask all students to abide by the guidelines.
