

Program Costs

Room and Board



This three and a half day program costs **\$260.00 per student** and includes Room and Board. In addition, there is an **Instructor Charge** of **\$20.00 per student** and a **Project Blank Charge**, both paid directly to the instructor when class begins on the first day of class.

Students that choose to commute, stay in their RV (must be self contained) or stay at nearby motels, pay a **per student charge of \$185.00** In addition, there is an **Instructor Charge** of **\$20.00 per student** and the **Project Blank Charge**, both paid directly to the instructor on the first day of class.

Accommodations

The Retreat is at the Environmental Education Center, part of the W. Alton Jones Campus of the University of Rhode Island. The facility is situated on 2,300 acres of pristine forests. There is a 75-acre lake, extensive hiking trails and a number of streams and ponds. There is also a historical farm and a replica of a Native American shelter and living area.

Students and Faculty stay in cabins on the retreat property. Cabins are rustic, with new showers and each cabin has 10 comfortable twin size bunk beds. Only the lower bunks are used. There are separate cabins for men and women. There are accommodations for couples.
