

## How to add a browser bookmark to your mobile device

### Follow these steps for iPhone:

1. From the Home screen, tap the Safari icon then navigate to the desired web page. [www.stvhscme.com](http://www.stvhscme.com)
2. Tap the Browser Menu Icon/More icon (located in the lower center).
3. Tap Add Bookmark.
4. Enter the information/name that you'd like for the bookmark then tap Save (upper right). By default, the label and address of the website currently visited appears.

### Follow these steps for Android:

1. Navigate to your Android web browser. Locate the icon that looks like a globe and tap to open.
2. Navigate to the desired web page. [www.stvhscme.com](http://www.stvhscme.com)
3. Tap on the Create Bookmark icon. This is the star outline icon to the right of the URL bar. An info box should appear asking you to name the bookmark and where you want it saved.
4. Tap on the drop-down menu. It can be found on the "Add to" choice.
5. Tap "Home Screen." You should now see your new bookmark on your phone's home screen.
