
#### From the Grand Chef de Gare

#### Stay well

The following guidelines from the Centers for Diseases Control and Prevention CDC could help you avoid the COVID-19 virus

Older adults and people who have severe underlying medical conditions like heart or lung disease or diabetes seem to be at higher risk for developing serious complications from COVID-19 illness.

#### **KNOW HOW IT SPREADS**

There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019, or COVID-19. The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus, which is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person:

- Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet):
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks;
- These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby, or possibly be inhaled into the lungs;
- Some recent studies have suggested COVID-19 may be spread by people who are not showing symptoms.

To prevent spread of COVID-19, everyone should:

• Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing.

It is especially important to wash hands:

- Before eating or preparing food;
- Before touching your face;
- After using the restroom;
- After leaving a public place;

- After blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing:
- After handling your cloth face covering;
- After changing a diaper;
- After caring for someone who is sick; and
- After touching animals or pets.

If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together.
