- 2. Emotional Security -Phil 4:6-7 "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. 'And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- 3. <u>Spiritual Security</u> Rom 8:38 –" For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, <sup>[K]</sup> neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, <sup>39</sup> neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."
