EQUITATION DIVISIONS

All equitation divisions to be judged on position, performance and horsemanship.

Leadline - Two age groups: 4 & Under, 5-6 Year Olds. No cross entry into any other division.

Walk-Trot - Open to riders 12 yrs and under who are not yet confident cantering in a group and who have not shown at the canter in any previous horseshow. May cross enter into any Walk-Trot class as eligible.

Mini Stirrup - Open to riders 10 yrs and under who have not yet shown over fences 2' or higher. May cross enter into Short Stirrup. Crossrails under 18", cantering not required.

Beginner Rider Equitation - Open to riders any age in their first or second year of showing who have not shown over fences exceeding 2'. Crossrails 18", cantering not required.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders 12 yrs and under who have not shown over fences exceeding 2' in any show. Crossrails 18".

Low Adult Equitation - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'. May not cross enter into the Adult Amateur Hunter Division.

Low Children's Equitation - Open to Junior riders, may not cross enter into the Children's Hunter Divisions. Fences 2'.

HUNTER DIVISIONS & PLEASURE DIVISIONS

All divisions judged on performance and way of going unless otherwise stated.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Riders 12 yrs and under who have not shown over fences exceeding 2' in height in any show. Crossrails 18".

Modified Hunter - Open to horses or ponies, all adult amateur riders or junior, fences 2'. Will be split into Adult Amateur and Junior sections if entries warrant.

Low Children's Pony Hunter - Open to Junior riders on ponies. All ponies jump 2'. May not cross enter into the Children's Hunter Divisions.

Children's Pony Hunter - Open to Junior riders on ponies. Small/Medium ponies to jump 2', Large ponies to jump 2'6". May not cross enter into Low Children's Pony Hunter or the Low Children's Equitation Division. **Low Children's Hunter Horse** - Open to horses ridden by Juniors. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Children's Hunter Divisions.

Children's/Adult Hunter Horse - Open to Junior riders and Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'9"-3'. May not cross enter into Low Children's Hunter, Low Children's Equitation divisions, Low Adult Hunter or Low Adult Equitation.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to horses or ponies ridden by Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to jump 2'9"-3'. May not cross enter into Low Adult Amateur Hunter.

Developing Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st year of showing over fences in the hunter division, regardless of age. Trotting anywhere on course permitted. Small verticals under 2', no oxers.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Ponies all to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting in corners not to be penalized.

Devon Open Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies, distances will not be adjusted for ponies. Fences 2'6" **Low Hunter** - Open to horses or ponies, all riders. Fences 2'6".

Pleasure Pony - Open to all ponies, any rider. Judged on suitability of pony to rider, performance and manners, four crossrails 18".

Pleasure Horse - Open to all horses, any rider. Judged on performance and manners, small verticals, no oxers, jumps 2'.

Local Pleasure - Open to all riders on horses or ponies stabled within 50 miles of the Devon showgrounds. Fences 2'.

EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES

Two tests will be built into the first round, no further testing:

- 200. M&S 2'6" Adult Medal Open to Adult Amateur riders.
- 201. M&S 2'6" Children's Medal Open to junior riders.
- 202. M&S Children's Pony Medal 2' Small/Medium ponies, 2'6" Large ponies
- 203. M&S Children's/Adult Horse Medal 3'
- 204. Low Children's Medal 2'

HUNTER DERBIES

To be run in the Hunt N' Go format.

Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including post and rail, hay bales, walls, hedge, brush and logs. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. The class format will consist of two phases: one Classic Hunter Phase, and one Handy Hunter Phase. The phases will be jumped consecutively with no break in pace. All participants will complete both the Classic and the Handy portions even if penalties (rails, refusal, etc.) are incurred. Major penalties (falls, three refusals, off course, etc.) will result in elimination. A single score will be given by the judge. Bonus points of one point per high option jump will be added to the score. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter between Derbies.

300. \$1,000 Catch 22 Hunter Derby - Fences 2'6" with option fences at 2'9".
