

## 4-H & FFA BARROW SHOW & SALE

### Eligibility Rules

1. The show is open to regularly 4-H members of 4-H clubs in Perry County, also to all members of Perryville FFA Chapter, who meet requirements of 4-H rules and FFA regulations. Members must be carrying barrow projects and have met all project requirements. The animals must be covered in the project record and approved by the 4-H leader and FFA teacher.
2. The 4-H and FFA Show and Sale Committee are not liable for the exhibitor or any mishandling.
3. All exhibitors must comply with general rules of the East Perry County Fair.
4. The barrow must be kept on the 4-H or FFA member's home farm or on a farm owned by the member's parents or guardians.
5. The barrow must be owned by July 1 of the current year.
6. All official entries must be sent to NANCY RICKENBERG, 2453 Hwy. NN St. Mary, MO 63673 by August 20.
7. Each youth is allowed to select 3 barrows by July 1 of the current year, only one barrow to sell in the barrow sale.
8. Barrows do not have to be purebred.
9. Barrows that have shown and sold in other youth show and sales are ineligible.
10. Barrows must weigh between 240 and 300 pounds to be eligible to show.
11. The barrows will be weighed at 4:00 P.M. on the Friday of the fair on portable scales furnished at the fairgrounds.
12. The Superintendent of the 4-H and FFA show and the Show and Sale Committee shall have the authority to eliminate any animal from the show that they feel does not meet eligibility.
13. 4-H & FFA Barrow will be shown and judged at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday.
14. 4-H or FFA exhibitors may sell only one barrow or one steer. They may not sell both a steer and a barrow.
15. Classes will be divided by age groups (13 and under, 14 and over) by January 1.
16. There will be a grand and reserve grand champion in both age groups and one overall champion and res.
17. Judging will be done on the danish system. Each point will be worth 10¢. Blue 30 Points, Red 20 Points, White 10 Points. Showmanship will automatically be judged in both age groups.
18. 4-H & FFA Barrow Sale will follow Steer Sale beginning at 4:30 P.M. Saturday.
19. Exhibitors are responsible for animal until 4:00 P.M. Saturday of the Fair if not sold.
20. Exhibitors must be SMQA Certified to show and sell.
21. A copy of the SMQA certificate or membership card attached to entry form.
