

MILTON 'WHITEY' FUERST

1931 - 1987

Funeral services were conducted at 11 a.m. Tuesday, Oct. 20 in St. John Lutheran Church, Kilmanagh for Milton "White" Fuerst, age 56, of 630 South Unionville Road, Bay Port, who died unexpectedly of an apparent heart attack at Scheurer Hospital, late Saturday afternoon, Oct. 17.

Rev. Robert Pfaff officiated and burial was in St. John's Cemetery. Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Fuerst was born in Sebewaing Township on April 4, 1931, the son of the late Christ and Florence (Unger) Fuerst. He was married to Frances Sigmund and she preceded him in death in 1969. On May 26, 1973, he and Donna Marie Wideman were married and she survives him. He was employed at Sebewaing Industries for 39 years, served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict, was a member of VFW Post #4115 of Sebewaing and a member of St. John Lutheran Church, Kilmanagh.
