friends, owned by Laurie Jo Jensen (then her lovely daughter, Merry!) and later by Kay Myers, and created by the incomparable Julie Froelich. Laurie and Kay are talented artists in their own right, and I have cherished pieces of theirs in my own vintage custom collection. And, well, Julie needs no introduction! So 21st Century Boy holds a particularly special place in my heart.

"In many ways, he embodies one of the things that make vintages so special--they have a history that traces through many beloved memories. They can weave their way through the lives of our friends and our community, gaining a kind of 'social patina' that adds to their uniqueness. I love that.

"Additional comments about the whole kit n' caboodle: Vintage customs constantly amaze me. The innovation and envelope-pushing they exemplify are so inspiring and reaffirming of our arts. Encapsulating our dreams, aspirations, and infinite creativity, vintage customs hold a special, almost hallowed place in our history, for sure, at least to me. They also represent a time when there was more of a DIYer aspect to all this--when more people could attain a reasonable measure of success with their own work than we've had in the recent past. All the seller could say was his name and about when he was made. They guessed '60s, but I knew it was 1974 or later based on the release date of the mold. I narrowed him to 1974 based on the style of hers from the same period. He is very charming in person, with a very INTRICATE pattern, and I have always liked that mold. He is a mystery regarding any show record. Would LOVE to know where he actually came from!"



DARK COMMANDER

Bay American Saddlebred stallion, CM by Adren King and Jason Ross in 1986

1980s Overall Champion Breed, Color, and Workmanship

Dark Commander was the Overall Champion in all three of his divisions in this leg, becoming only the fourth-ever "Triple Crown" hero in the history of the VCMEC Online World Championship series!

His owner, **Colleen Headley**, writes, "Dark Commander, my pint-sized peacock! He was remade by Adren King, who took a Little Bit Saddlebred and straightened the legs to create a Saddlebred posed for halter. I am still amazed by this mighty little model. The repaint, hair and facial carving were done by Jason Ross and the oh so fine braids by Ava Maureen Durbin. The first time I photo-judged him, Dark Commander became one of my 'holy grail' horses. Thank goodness Adren (who owned him) has a sense of humor because I lost track of the many times I asked to buy this little charmer. I eventually wore him down, but it was helpful that we were good friends and he knew I would treasure him forever. Dark Commander was created in 1986 and he wears his years with grace. I will be forever grateful to Adren for selling him to me and placing this little show-off in my barn."

Judge **Sarah Minkiewicz-Breunig** comments, "Dark Commander simply commanded the competition. He perfectly represents the winning trifecta of impeccable breed type, a beautifully done color done in Jason Ross' iconic style, and impeccable workmanship. From his color to his sculpting, he's put together well and just oozes Saddlebred to boot. He also radiates personality and charisma--a very 'look at me' presence that's so Saddlebred. What's more, he's done on a very difficult mold, and done so well, he was way ahead of his time. He'd have no problem competing today. I'm also a real stickler for good construction (including anatomy) and I have pet peeves--and he has none of them. For example, his extended, stretched hind legs don't have that curved, bent quality to the gaskins that is so common in vintages in that position. He's also properly refined and elegant for a Saddlebred, not clunky and beefy as so many vintage ASBs are. He's just a singular piece all around."

Ardith Carlton writes, "The world has a wealth of wonderful model Paint stallions... but of 'em all, to my mind, it's tough to top Cheyenne Ridge.

"Created by Carol Williams from a Breyer Trakehner in the 1980s, Cheyenne Ridge was front and center in the lead photo for Jean Lindgren's marvelous article for the December 1989 issue of *Paint Horse Journal*, "Model Makers Compete in Scaled-Down

Paint Horse Shows." Carol had photoed her Adonis of an overo standing in a stream, with his dismounted rider relaxing on a nearby rock in the water, holding his reins.

"Soon after that issue came out, in leafing through it I was completely fooled by that photo at first glance; thought the horse in the water was real and would be a great idea for a model! Then I noticed the oddly shiny pate of the doll, and the words on the page finally registered. That great idea for a model was already a model?! I became a Cheyenne Ridge fan on the spot!

"In those days, Carol occasionally had saleslists of new horses and a few members of her show string. I was lucky to acquire some standout stock horses that way--and every time, I asked after Cheyenne Ridge. One day, to my utter shock and delight, she decided to sell him to me!



"There was just one condition...she explained that he had developed some structural issues, and that she'd like to re-work him. I agreed, and in 1995, chestnut overo Cheyenne Ridge was reborn as his bay overo son Crusher Joe!

"Contrary from the start, Joe promptly took a detour in the mail, worrying Carol and me sick as he wandered somewhere for six weeks between Kansas and Ohio before finally arriving safely, whew!

"He went on to be the NAMHSA 1996 NAN National Champion Custom Paint Horse and 1997 NAN Reserve National Champion Custom Paint Horse, both times in against the revolutionary Rlo Rondo QH-1 artist resins Carol also created. Carol told me she prefers him to the QH-1, and it's gratifying whenever judges agree!

"Unlike in his photogenic former life, Joe is not fond of cameras; I haven't been able to take a decent show photo of him at all. This photo entered in VCMEC is just a reference shot taken in a storage unit. Am so happy that he managed to do well despite it! Thanks so much!"



VCMEC Triple Crown Winner *THE RAISULI Revisited!

In last issue's news of *The Raisuli sweeping the overall championships in all three 1960s/1970s divisions of the third leg of the 2018-19 VCMEC Online World Championship series, the comments of judge **Lois Bennington** were inadvertently left out. Very sorry about that, Lois! Here they are:

Lois wrote, "The year 2019 will be the 45th year of model horses being part of my life. Over the years, I have seen many beautiful customs created by the best artists in the hobby. However, it is rare for me to remember a horse after all these years. But there is one that immediately comes to mind, even though I only saw him once during a photo show I had many years ago. He would be Nancy Strowger's OBI WAN OF VALKARTH. I still remember the Instamatic picture of him under saddle competing in some sort of trail class.

There was one horse in the 1960s-1970s division that is that caliber of a horse. *The Raisuli was created in 1977 and would have been light years ahead of most customs of that era. The description given is 'Rose grey Arabian stallion. Breyer CM Proud Arabian Stallion with remake by Beth Peart/repaint and thread mane/tail by Nancy Strowger in 1977.'

I remember Beth Peart coming to Cleveland Nationals in the early 1980s and blowing us away with her remakes. Add a wonderful thread mane and tail, a beautiful paint job and facial detail that only Nancy could do, and this model is stunning. It is no wonder that he is a Triple Crown winner during the VCMEC show series! Congratulations to the owner. He will haunt me forever!"
