



Sand Dollar Show Series

Class Descriptions and Rules

Schooling Crossrails – Open to all riders. Fence height 18”

Beginner Crossrails – Open to junior and amateur riders in their first or second year of showing over fences. Crossrail height 18”

Beginner Crossrails Medal – Open to junior and amateur riders in their first or second year of showing over fences. Riders may be asked to halt, sit the trot or perform a rollback turn. Crossrail height 18”

Beginner Crossrails Hunter Derby- Open to Junior and Amateur riders in their first or second year of showing over fences. Crossrail height 18” Riders may be asked to halt, hand gallop a fence, dismount.

Evergreen – Open to all riders and horses. Fence height 2’

Short/Long Stirrup – Open to Junior and Amateur riders in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18” but lower than 2’6”. Fence height 2’0

Short/Long Stirrup Medal - Open to Junior and Amateur riders in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18” but lower than 2’6”. Riders may be asked to halt, sit the trot, or perform a rollback. Fence height 2’0”

Evergreen Hunter Derby – Open to riders and horses. Fence height 2’

Special- Open to all riders and horses. Fence height 2’3”

Pre-Child/Adult – Open to Junior and Amateur riders who have never shown over fences at 2’6” or higher. Fence height 2’3”

Pre-Child/Adult Medal – Open to Junior and Amateur riders who have never shown over fences at 2’6” or higher. Riders may be asked to sit the trot, halt, or perform a rollback. Fence height 2’3”

Special Hunter Derby – Open to all. Riders may be asked to halt, dismount, or hand gallop a fence.

Low 2’6” – Open to all. Fence height 2’6”

Low Child/Adult – Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Fence height 2'6".

Low Child/Adult Medal – Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Riders may be asked to halt, back up, sit the trot or perform a rollback. Fence Height 2'6"

Low Child/Adult Hunter – Open to Junior and Amateur riders who have never shown over fences at 2'9" or higher at any show.

Low Hunter – Open to all. Fence height 2'6"

Low Hunter Derby – Open to all. Riders may be asked to hand gallop a fence, dismount, or halt. Fence height 2'6".

High Equitation – Open to all riders. Fence height 2'9".

High Child/Adult Equitation – Open to Juniors and Amateur riders. Fence height 2'9".

High Child/Adult Medal – Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Riders may be asked to sit the trot, halt, or perform a rollback. Fence height 2'9".

Working Hunter – Open to all riders. Fence height 2'9".

High Hunter Derby – Open to all riders. Riders may be asked to dismount, hand gallop a fence or halt. Fence height 2'9"

Leadline- Open to riders 5 years and younger.

Walk Only- Open to Junior and Amateur riders.

Beginner Western Walk/Jog- Open to Junior and Amateur riders that have not shown or are in their first year of showing at the lope. Can cross enter into individual canter.

Open Western Walk/Jog- Open to all riders. Can cross enter.

Beginner Walk/Jog/Lope- Open to Junior and Amateur riders in their first or second year of showing at the lope. Can cross enter in open walk/jog

Open Walk/Jog/Lope- Open to all riders. Can cross enter.

Walk/Individual Trot- Open to Junior and Amateur riders in their first or second year of showing, can cross enter into walk only division. Will be asked to trot one long side of the arena. English and western to be pinned as different divisions.

Schooling Walk/Trot- Open to all riders. Can cross enter.

Beginner Walk/Trot- Open to Junior riders that have not shown or are in their first year of showing at the canter. Can cross enter into individual canter.

Adult Walk/Trot- Open to Amateur riders that have not shown or are in their first year of showing at the canter. Can cross enter into individual canter.

Walk/Trot/Individual canter- Open to Junior and Amateur riders, can cross enter into walk/trot or walk/lope. Will be asked to canter one long side of the arena. English and Western to be pinned as different divisions.

Schooling Walk/Trot/Canter- Open to all riders. Can cross enter.

Beginner Walk/Trot/Canter- Open to Junior riders in their first or second year of showing at the canter. Can cross enter into poles.

Adult Walk/Trot/Canter- Open to Amateur riders in their first or second year of showing at the canter. Can cross enter into poles.

Beginner Poles- Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Trot or canter. Two outside lines of poles, twice around the arena.
