

# WINTER WEATHER REMINDER

---

## FROM THE CITY OF REINBECK

This is a friendly reminder from the City of Reinbeck. Having received our first snow accumulations for the year, we observed numerous violations of the snow removal ordinances. The City is seeking to inform residents of the ordinances in place. Obeying these ordinances helps to get the streets cleared more efficiently and keep residents safe when utilizing the sidewalks. You can view the detailed snow ordinances at City Hall. Below is a summary of each ordinance.

**Parking Ordinance:** No person shall park, abandon, or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley or City-owned off-street parking area between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during the months of November, December, January, February, and March.

**Violators:** You may be issued a parking citation for each violation. Habitual violator's vehicle may be towed and stored at the owner's expense.

**Sidewalk Ordinance:** It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice, and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a property owner does not remove snow, ice, or accumulations within a reasonable time, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. (A reasonable time would be 24 hours.)

**Violators will receive a 24-hour notice** from City Hall to clear their sidewalks of accumulations. If it is not cleared, the city will clear the sidewalk and bill the home owner. Non-payment costs will be assessed against the property as a property tax. Please remember to use ice melt or other traction material for icy spots. *If you would like a list of contacts for snow removal for hire, please stop by City Hall. If you are a contractor who would like to be on this list, please sign up at City Hall.*

**Snowmobile Ordinance:** If you plan on operating a snowmobile, please stop in at city hall and pick up a copy of the ordinance.

By working together and following the ordinances, Reinbeck will have safer streets and sidewalks and it will make the streets easier to travel on this winter season.
