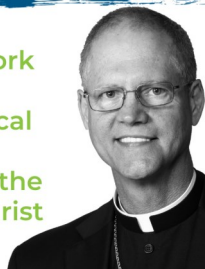

UGANDAN ORPHANS' BENEFIT CONCERT

On Sunday, May 12, a benefit concept will take place at 4:00 pm at the First Presbyterian Church in Port Townsend located at 1111 Franklin St. Doors open at 3:30 pm. There is a \$15-\$20 suggested donation for ages 12 and older. There are 15 million AIDS orphans in Africa, 1 million in Uganda alone. MOTHER'S DAY BASKET RAFFLE COMING UP!

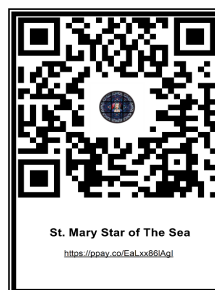
