In March, we at the Vintage Custom Model Equine Center were thrilled to receive a package from Laurel Orrin, whose photography services helped make the work of Linda Leach and Mary Sue Barnum stars in model horse photo-showrings in the 1970s and '80s. Laurel donated to our Museum a quartet of vintage custom equines from her longtime collection!

This important group is led by an early creation by Michigan artist Linda Leach: a Breyer Proud Arabian Stallion customized from its original standing position to become a boldly trotting fleabitten grey Arabian mare. Laurel owned this horse since the mid-1970s, and believes it is the first model on which Linda Leach resculpted the legs.

At the mare's side is a beautiful bay filly, positioned running with her thread mane and tail streaming, created by Elaine McDaniel in 2001 from the standing Breyer Family Arabian Foal.

The noted equine sculptor Candace Liddy customized some Breyer horses in the 1990s, and thanks to Laurel, the Museum now has a marvelous Liddy example from 1995. This trotting bay stallion is a real hefty handful; it took a lot of epoxy and resculpting to complete his transformation from what may have been the Breyer Classic Lipizzan!

Completing the quartet is an engaging Appaloosa foal that Laurie Jo Jensen created from a Breyer Classic Andalusian Foal in 1999. Laurie Jo has conducted painting workshops at BreyerFest and designed colorways for Stone Model Horses, and this colorful guy really shows off her paintwork.

Thank you so much, Laurel--the Museum is honored to welcome this wonderful quartet! They're safely behind glass in a temporary cabinet as they await the opening of the VCMEC Hobby House & Museum.



### Bailing Twine, Bubble Gum, and a Will of Iron: Remembering Marney

April 3 marked the passage of 25 years since the world lost Marney J. Walerius, godmother of the model horse hobby. To celebrate her life and legacy, this issue gathers some favorite Marney stories, peppered with peeks at fun entries in her annual Model Horse Con-

gress live show! For those not fortunate enough to have met her, below is a must-read 1992 tribute (uncredited, but written on behalf of the hobby by Ardith Carlton with the assistance of Julie Froelich), courtesy of The Hobby Horse News and White Horse Productions' Model Horse History page (http://www.whitehorseproductions.com/history.html).

# A Tribute to Marney J. Walerius

She brought thousands of us together, and turned others' sneers at our "playing with toys" into curiosity and, finally, respect. She was a driving force in founding a hobby where education is exciting; where we have competition and sportsmanship, the thrill of creation, the satisfaction in a job well done. Where horses do not die, and where lifelong friendships can be made.

In the quarter-century that she helped guide our hobby's history, we have been striving hard to capture the illusion of life in miniature. The harsh reality of life is out there, but, thankfully, has rarely made itself felt—beyond the losses of sculptors Christian Hess and Rich Rudish, the hobby still seems like a joyous new endeavor, with untold fun to be had, discoveries to be made, and ideas to be pioneered. We may never reach the horizon, but think of the wonderful time that's ahead for us, trying to!

But on April 3, 1992, the model horse hobby's childhood came to an abrupt end. Marney J. Walerius died of a heart attack at age 43.

Marney did not single-handedly found the hobby; friends Simone Smiljanic (who with Marney co-founded the International Model Horse Association), Karen and Sandra Baehr (who produced the newsletter *Plastic Horse World*) and Ellen Hitchens (editor of *The Hitching Post*) were also instrumental. But that quartet eventually left the hobby for other pursuits, and for the last decade, Marney was the only hobby founder still actively involved, still reachable and answering questions, still teaching and involving others.

She began collecting Breyers in 1960 (a collection that would come to include 5,000 horses), and eight years later Marney was the hobby's "squeaky wheel," writing to Breyer's management about problems with models. The result was any hobbyist's dream come true: she was asked to be a consultant for the company, and Marney helped guide color and mold choices to improve the realism of Breyer's releases.

Informal live shows had been held sporadically in backyards and living rooms beginning in the late 1960s, and in 1973 and 1974, Marney's own backyard featured an event that would soon graduate to hotel ballrooms and grow into an annual, four-day model extravaganza, the International Model Horse Congress.

Seventeen renewals of the event were held under Marney's direction and selfless dedication. One year, she had eye surgery just before the show; another year she slipped in an elevator during the show and broke her leg. Yet neither setback could stop her, and the show, from going on. Her body was fragile, but her determination kept her going.

In fact, Marney was seemingly made of bailing twine, bubble gum, and a will of iron. Long a diabetic, she eventually lost a leg to the disease when her brittle bones could not heal. Marney had suffered broken bones and undergone various surgeries throughout her life, and her health worsened.

Marney traveled throughout North America nonetheless, guest-judging at live shows and making herself available to help and educate hobbyists. And at the inaugural BreyerFest at the Kentucky Horse Park in 1990, Marney was presented the BreyerFest Recognition Award for years of support and encouragement to all who collect Breyer models: an OF black tobiano Saddlebred Weanling.

The ultimate authority on Breyer OF models, Marney was given a new goal to target in the late 1980s, when a Breyer reference book she had written—based on records she had painstakingly compiled since 1960—became snarled in snafus with two backers. The unpublished manuscript was in limbo for over six years, before Marney managed to rescue it.

Her deep conviction to share her knowledge with all collectors, and help them fully understand the product they were collecting, drove her determination to put everything she had into getting the book published herself. And in February 1992, a 3,000-copy printing of *The Breyer Models Reference and Insurance Guide* at last became a reality.

Two months later, having left the world and the hobby a better place, Marney was buried in Minnesota.

Her mother Elaine and brother Gary will sort through her papers as soon as Elaine has recovered from upcoming surgeries, and it is asked that hobbyists please do *not* bother the family about Marney's belongings. Contact Bentley Sales Company (642 Sandy Lane, Des Plaines, IL 60016) with questions you may have. Bentley also will handle sales of the book.

At BreyerFest, this August 1 at the Kentucky Horse Park, a tree and stone marker will be dedicated in Marney's name. The tree grows in a place she loved, and symbolizes the hobby growing from the roots Marney helped establish. May her tree, and our hobby, continue to grow and flourish for generations to come.

Nance Feldman remembered, "Marney had a great, positive influence on me as a young teen in the mid-70s.

"I had little idea what I was doing but I really wanted to participate in model horse show-



ing. When a live show hosted by Marney was announced in one of the model horse publications, my Dad agreed to drive with my Mom and me to Barrington, IL. Marney was so welcoming and encouraging! When I babbled about my entries and their flaws Marney kept replying, 'That doesn't bother me.' I began feeling more confident and had a great time! I will always remember that first show."

Kathy Wells wrote, "The first time I met Marney in person, it was like a time warp. Friends who know her best know Marney was wardrobe-challenged. It was 1975 and she was meeting my sister and I at O'Hare. This lady dressed in '60s western fashion, stretch polyester denim western jeans tucked into tall pointy-toed western boots, snap-button western yolk blouse, the kind Dale Evans would be proud to wear, and long brown loose hair. All that was missing was a holster and cowboy hat. Marney was quite a sight to behold.

"When I knew her better I enquired about her wardrobe and she told me it was an old riding ensemble. Still perfectly good. No use throwing it out. Marney was quite the gymkhana rider with her pinto In a Tiff years earlier.



"One year someone suggested that Marney only held Congress to make gobs and gobs of money to live off. Grrr. This was long before the Internet. Ya know I've no idea if she ever made a profit off Congress but after being there and seeing first hand the hard work she put into it, if she did, good for her!

"I remember one year the day before Congress we went on a road trip to I believe Indiana to rescue a shower whose car died on the freeway. It was a long trip that took the better part of Thursday but we rescued this shower and transferred all her models and luggage into the station wagon. That was Marney.

"My most lasting impression is how she vividly described the growth of our hobby as it is NOW way back in the early '80s."

Julie Froelich shared, "After Marney got diabetes, she had to have a leg amputated, and it caused her a lot of trouble and pain. There was a lot of trouble with the stump and adapting it to various artificial legs, and there were many occasions when she was judging at Congress and was in tears due to

the pain. At times like that, lots of us would do everything we could to help her out in any way that we could. She often had to remove her artificial leg and use a wheelchair to judge.

"Because of her leg, she had handicapped plates on her car. One time, she had gone to a store, and found that an able-bodied person had thoughtlessly parked their car in the handicapped spot.

"Marney was, of course, furious, but she had her own way of dealing with this. She got on the phone and called the police, and then she called the local newspaper. When the guy came out of the store to retrieve his car, he found Marney on the hood of his car with her artificial leg off, beating the hood of his car with her artificial leg for the newspaper cameras!

"Marney commissioned some horses from me over the years, although she didn't have a particularly favorite breed, pose or color of horse. For example, when she commissioned the horse that would eventually become RM

Colorvision, she asked for 'a stock mare in chestnut pinto,' and I just went from there.

"Her collection was across a broad spectrum of breeds. I went to the dispersal sale that was held after she passed away, and there were any



number of different breeds represented among the custom horses there. Although she did seem to have a fondness for unusual stuff, and she certainly asked me to paint more than a few dapple greys for her!"

**Kathy Wells** added, "One of Marney's most winningest remakes was a three-gaited American Saddlebred by Kathleen Maestas...Imperial Diamond? He was a bay with a roached mane, in action.

"I was with Marney when she met this model for the first time. It was the only time Kathleen and her husband Louis



drove to Congress. We had a private showing of Kathleen's sales horses. I wanted this model very badly but he was quite pricey. I even suggested to Marney that we purchase him in partnership and

share him. Marney didn't dismiss the idea but she wanted to know where the model was going to reside. In the end Marney bought him for herself. Being the show hostess she had first pick. I settled for another. But geez, what a thrill, getting to see the sales horses first!

"Marney was extremely proud of her remakes," Kathy continued. "Marney lacked the skills to remake but she made up for this by literally entering her horses in every conceivable class.



It was not unusual back then for horses to do it all, English, western, harness, costume etc. All you needed was the tack and good photos. So her horses won by default, having

entered every class they could. I often judged photo shows and Marney's horses were always well represented.

"Marney was SO PROUD of Miss Sneaker Feet, a walking palomino Lady Phase she had done herself. The walking was done simply by heating the legs up and twisting and pulling into motion. The upper body was never touched but the legs looked like she was walking on egg shells. The poor horse looked extremely lame. Like she had navicular in all four legs. No one had the heart to tell her the horse looked lame. Ironic though, out of all of Marney's models this is the one I would have liked as a keepsake and wondered her fate."



Trying to make judge Marney smile was a mission for some showers, including **Julie Froelich**. Julie recalled, "One year at Model Horse Congress I saw Marney mark down the Western Trail entry of a shower whose trail obstacle consisted of an outhouse, with the horse tied up outside, awaiting its owner to finish their pit stop. She marked the display down because when Marney opened the outhouse door, it was empty!

"So I decided to fix that. I made my own outhouse trail obstacle, and took a John Duke Mego doll from the 'Dukes of Hazzard' and remade him so he was anatomically correct. I also detailed the outhouse to the nines, with a newspaper for



him to read painstakingly xeroxed down from our local newspaper, a roll of toilet paper, a wasp nest inside the outhouse, and a bird's nest on the outside, complete with baby swallows inside the nest. The handle on the outhouse was missing and had been re-



placed with a piece of rope, based on memories of many outhouses I'd encountered myself.

"At the next show where Marney judged, I carefully set up my outhouse, tied the horse outside, and added John Duke at his leisure with his newspaper inside the outhouse. And then I waited.

"Sure enough, when Marney got to my display, I heard a loud indignant shriek, and then: 'JULIE!!'

"'What?' I replied innocently.

"'You KNOW...!' Marney exclaimed.

"'Did you open the outhouse door?' I asked.

"'Yes!'

"'Well then,' I laughed, 'you got what you deserved!"

**Kathy Wells** has fond memories of trips with Marney. "There was the time we rode the train into downtown Chicago to the main Breyer Animal Creations headquarters. I'm a farm girl. I had never been in a city that size. I met Peter Stone's father, the CEO of Breyer Molding Company. Breyer did injection molding, inserts for suitcases and other items. The

models were only a sideline.

"On another trip we drove to the Rockford plant where the models were shipped from. This is where I met Peter Stone for the first time. Peter was President of Breyer Animal



Creations and VP of Breyer Molding. Imagine an entire warehouse full of models! At the end of a brief tour Marney asked my help in loading some models. Believe it or not we proceeded to fill up the family station wagon with 'reject' Breyer horses. You can fit a lot of bodies into a station wagon. I was getting really nervous. Marney said to help myself. I modestly took 4-5 and felt guilty at that. When Marney saw how few I was taking she urged me to take more. So I added a 6th while she crammed several more into the wagon. When I protested she said they'll never miss these, it's OK, I do this all the time. Indeed she did. Marney was on disability by this time and she literally lived off her model sales. On the way home we swung by Peter Stone's farm near the Rockford plant. Marney stopped to say hi to his family."



Julie Froelich reminisced about another visit to the company. "Back when Peter Stone still worked for Breyer, at the time when Marney was doing some work for Breyer herself, he had promised her a particular test run model. She and I and a couple of other people went to Brever for a tour, and she was excited because Peter had told her he'd give her the model at the tour, and she was telling us all about it in the car on the way there.

"However, unbeknownst to Marney, Peter Stone decided to keep the model rather than give it to her. During the tour, Marney spotted the model sitting on a sideboard, and unfortunately Peter Stone did not give her the model when the tour ended. In the car on the way back home, one of the other people who'd attended the tour with us reached into her purse and handed the model to Marney--she'd 'liberated' it while they were on the way out!"

**Ardith Carlton** wrote, "Back in those lazy hazy pre-Internet days, Corky Visminas and I once had the crazy luck to find a blue OF Running Mare with a few other old Breyers (in, of all

places, a used record shop!). We'd heard of OF Brevers called 'decorators' that were blue or gold, but had never actually seen one, so got on the horn to our model guru, Julie Froelich. Julie suggested calling Marney and gave me her phone number.



"I had never met Marney and was too shy

to call for a few days, but curiosity finally won out--and when I rang, Marney was very welcoming and seemed tickled that I'd been sent her way. She encouraged me to describe the horse, and then calmly and analytically asked some questions about things like the shade of blue and whether there were areas of white showing through on the mare's body...and then, although she understandably couldn't say 100% for sure without seeing the horse, she congratulated us on having found what sure sounded to be an OF decorator Wedgewood Running Mare! That was the only time I had the good fortune to speak with Marney, but will always remember her expertise, humility, and just plain kindness.'

**Corky Visminas** recalled, ""I talked to her on the phone once; she'd called to talk to Liz Bouras, I think, and I got the call first. I was like, 'OMG, you're Marney Walerius! I'm so thrilled to talk to you!' and she laughed and said 'Why!?!' We got to chat for a few minutes, which was very enjoyable for me. Then at Breyerfest, I believe the same year, I got to meet her

face to face. I shook her hand, told her I loved showing model horses, that I'd been collecting them since I was 4, and that I was very grateful to her for her hand in starting the hobby. She was again very humble and lots of fun to talk to

"Ardith was part of the committee who brought together the first NAMHSA North American Nationals show, and a couple of days before the first-ever NAN show in 1995, I had a dream about Marney.

"I was in a cornfield on a blue-sky day, with the corn towering high. Marney was there as well, smiling and looking very hale and hearty. I told her about NAN, how so many people had worked so hard to make this show a reality, and that everyone was very excited that it was finally going to happen. She seemed very pleased by this.

"In the background, Scully and Mulder from 'X-Files' were standing next to a Volkswagen Beetle. Scully kept looking at her watch. I guess Marney's time to say hello from the other side was drawing short. I'm just glad I had a chance to tell her about NAN, and that she seemed to approve."

In closing, Kathy Wells confided, "There are times I feel her presence. None more so than just after I received word of her passing.

"Bonnie (Sumser) Elber called to tell me of Marney's passing. I held myself together until I got off the phone. Then I lost it. I started sobbing uncontrollably.

"Suddenly I was not alone. I distinctly heard Marney's voice and felt her presence. I was enveloped in a warm hug and message, 'Please don't cry for me, I don't hurt anymore. I have my leg back, I am free.'

"I've only told a couple people this encounter. It was very real and oh so Marney. There have been other times I have felt her presence. But none as vivid as the first. I keep a curio size photo of her in my kitchen. She taught me so much."

She was a show jumper. She came clippedy-clopping, prancing into the ring, snorting and huffing, her veins popping under her skin. Yep, she was hot. She had the most collected canter ever, haha. And she was utterly memorable. She could jump, and was quite a spectacle to watch. All these years later, I remember Flicka.'

Ardith Carlton writes, "Am thrilled that this epic stallion—the second of Julie Froelich's masterpiece Morgans remade from a Breyer Lady Phase—did well! But it's moving too that he gets to be featured in this issue devoted to Marney Walerius, because Marney was in a way responsible for him coming into my hands.

"Soon after Marney passed away in April 1994, Julie bought a memorial tree for her at the Kentucky Horse Park, with the plaque 'In Memory of Marney J. Walerius: Roots of the Model Horse Hobby.' Julie had acted alone in making this beautiful tribute possible, and only mentioned it when sharing Marney stories with me for the memorial I was writing that ran in The Hobby Horse News.

"Corky and I were strapped for cash, what with costs for the upcoming trip to BreyerFest, but wanted to contribute in some way. That way announced itself

when we went to the monthly Scotts Antique Market at the Ohio State Fairgrounds, where there were almost never any model horses: The world's most gorgeous OF Breyer glossy charcoal Mustang, nose skyward, awaited us!

"We brought him to BreyerFest, intending to sell him and send the proceeds to Julie as a thank-you from the hobby for the tree. As we were starting to tag the sale horses in our room, though, a hobbyist walked in, carrying an open box with a few remakes standing in it. She was looking to trade for vintage OFs. Among the horses standing in her box were RM Dancing Star, who was a Lady Phase CM as a dun QH mare that Julie had once mentioned regretting selling, and Sympathy For The Demon, who the hobbyist pointed out was having a strange filler issue, with a small soft area.

"She was crazy for the OF glossy charcoal Mustang...and by trade's end, Corky and I had both RM Dancing Star, who we sent to Julie as a thank-you present from the hobby for Marney's tree, and Sympathy For The Demon, one of Julie's most iconic remakes, for ourselves. The way it all worked out--complete with the filler issue healing itself within a few months--we treasure Sympathy For The Demon all the more, suspecting Marney had something to do with nudging the planets into alignment!"

has the SSS Syndicate brand on his left hind quarter. Originally owned by Julie, then Laurie Jo Jensen. Laurie gave him to her daughter Merryl with strict instructions that he could only ever be sold to me or Sarah Minkiewicz-Breunig.



"That said, this swaggering stud has a past! Paula O'Keefe calls it, 'The meeting of the Killer Glam Ponies: Julie Froelich's 21st Century Boy, and Colonel Megalomania (a/k/a 'and who does YOUR hair?') by Judy [Renee Pope]. The pink hair and 'high heels' were key character points. I \*think\* they were both originally Classic Men O'War."




