# **Entry limits:**

350 runs with jumps per day; 500 runs total per day

### Move ups:

Move-ups, corrections & changes to entries will be accepted until June 25, 2019, at 6:00 PM PDT. Corrections & changes will not be made at the trial; no exceptions.

Move-ups from Saturday to Sunday for duplicated classes will be taken until the end of the last class on Saturday. Same-day move-ups will not be accepted. No exceptions.

## Day of show entries:

### Refunds:

- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if requested before or on the closing date. After the closing date, injured or ill handlers or injured, ill, or in-heat dogs will receive a refund, less a \$20 per dog handling fee. Verification from a doctor or vet may be requested.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal.
- There will be no refunds for withdrawals requested on or after the first competition date listed in this premium, regardless of the reason.

## **Confirmations:**

Corrections and changes to entries will be accepted until the pre-trial move up deadline. Corrections and changes will not be made at the trial; no exceptions.

It is the competitor's responsibility to check the entry confirmation for errors and to promptly report them to the Trial Secretary. It is also the competitor's responsibility to contact the Trial Secretary if they have not received a confirmation email by June 27, 2019.

## Food info:

There will <u>not</u> be a food vendor on site. Light hospitality and lunch will be provided for workers. Local food options are limited so please plan accordingly. There's a mini-mart and coffee stand in Brownsville, and a mini-mart with a deli at I-5 Exit 216 (Halsey) exit for Brownsville.

## Volunteer info:

There will be a whiteboard at the trial to sign up to work. Workers will earn coupons to use for lunch or for tickets for the workers' raffle. Experience is not needed for any job; we will teach you. Thanks in advance for your help!

## Awards and ribbons:

Purple rosettes will be awarded for all qualifying runs. Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place in each jump height in Intro and Novice classes. Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place for each jump height and class for all other levels.

#### JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler Divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

# **Brief Summary of Rules:**

Please refer to www.nadac.comfor a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course. No, food, toys, or clickers within 10 feet of the ring. Food or small toys can be in a secure container in pocket during a containerized trial.
- The sponsoring club/s will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

#### **AGREEMENT**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor/owner assumes the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Willamette Agility Group (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and the City of Brownsville (including its officers, directors, and members) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of exhibitor/owner's participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

# Additionally:

- Checks will be held until the closing date. There will be a \$20 service charge for returned checks. Payment in full of entry fees and service charges shall be made by money order or cash before the first date of competition listed in this premium.
- The running order will be determined at the club's discretion. An attempt will be made to separate runs for handlers with more than one dog in a class.
- Exhibitors are advised that Pioneer Park is public property. Other public and private events may occur within the park on the same dates as this trial. To ensure the continued availability of this site, exhibitors must conduct themselves in a responsible and respectful manner. Exhibitors are responsible for the appropriate conduct of their guests, children, and dogs.
- Exhibitors are expected to follow all City of Brownsville rules for the park, including but not limited to:
  - No alcoholic beverages allowed; violators will be cited.
  - No firearms.
  - No fireworks.
  - Fires permitted in designated areas only.
  - No loud or abusive language or noise
  - Vehicles must stay on roads and designated areas only.
  - Follow the 5 mph speed limit.
  - Dispose of trash properly.
  - Keep dogs on-leash unless in off-leash areas. Keep dogs under control at all times.
  - Please clean up after your dog.

# Lodging info and directions:

#### **CAMPING**

Tent and RV/vehicle camping is available at Pioneer Park on Friday through Sunday nights. Camping is arranged between WAG and the City of Brownsville. Camping spots are available on a first come, first served basis. Restrooms are available, but there are no showers or hookups. Camping west of the road closest to the river is not allowed.

Fill out the camping section on the entry form, including the arrival and departure dates, and add the camping fees to your total payment to WAG. WAG will give the City a list with each camper's name, camping type, and arrival and departure dates. WAG must receive your camping information and payment by the trial closing date of June 22. This is because of the extra time needed to coordinate with the City.

Camping permits will be prepared by the City and will be available from WAG by trial set-up time on Friday, June 28. For tent camping, the permit must be produced upon request by the City or WAG. For RV/vehicle camping, the permit must be displayed so it's clearly visible from outside of your rig.

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE**

**Address:** 200 W. Park Street, Brownsville, OR 97379

From I-5, take Exit 216 (Highway 288). Go east on Highway 288 for just over 4 miles until you reach Brownsville. In Brownsville, turn left (north) onto Main Street and then left (west) onto Park Street. Park Street dead-ends at Pioneer Park.

Continue into the park and follow the road to the left (south) to the ball fields. The trial is held in the baseball field at the south end of the park. The field is mostly fenced on all sides.

## Measurement:

Dogs under 18", entered in Proficient, and without a permanent height cards must be measured before they run. Dogs entered in Skilled do not have to be measured. Permanent height card measurements will be available during the weekend. The Trial Secretary will contact you if measurement is necessary for your dog/s.

## "Containerized" trial:

This is a "containerized" trial. Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a Ziploc bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container may not be visible in the ring or within 10 feet of the ring. You may not indicate to your dog that you have this item on you (e.g., by patting your pocket). The container may not be removed from your pocket until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none may be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys and to diminish the incidence of dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates.
