



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

BACKGROUND:

The Alta Loma Riding Club Scholarship program is designed to provide education assistance to members and family of the riding club. Monies allocated to the scholarship fund will be divided according to the number of qualified applicants. Three scholarships will be awarded as follows:

- If there are three winners, the first award will receive 50% of the money allocated; the second and third awards will receive 30% and 20% respectively.
- If there are two winners, the first award will receive 60% of the money allocated and the second winner will receive 40% of the money allocated
- If there is one winner, they will receive 100% of the money allocated

Scholarship funds will be awarded based on the applicant meeting the scholarship requirements, completing the application, meeting the deadline and completing a written essay. Each applicant will be scored by the Board of Directors of the ALRC, based on the following criteria:

- The applicant's participation in ALRC events will consist of 50% of the score.
- The written essay will consist of 30% of the score.
- The applicant's current grade point average will consist of 20% of the score.

REQUIREMENTS:

- The applicant must be a current ALRC member.
- Membership dues must be paid to qualify as a member and the member must be in good standing.
- An applicant can be a recipient of the scholarship a maximum of four (4) times.
- An applicant must maintain a 2.0 grade point (C) average or higher.
- The applicant must comply with the scholarship rules.

RULES:

- The applicant must complete the application and attach proof of college registration and current grade point average (official transcripts or report card).
- High school graduates who have not enrolled must have a counselor letter of intention to enroll.
- The applicant must complete the written essay in 500 words or less.
