

## Summer Reading for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade

**This book report is due on the first day of school. This assignment will appear as part of a literature grade for the first quarter. The assessment is worth 25 points.**

### **Step one:**

Students are required to read any fiction book of their choice. The book must be at least 200 pages or more. Please select a book that you have not already read.

### **Step two:**

Student is required to read the book.

### **Step three:**

Student is required to complete the following writing assignment by answering the following questions in paragraph form. Please type the paper and use 12 font, double-spaced, and one-inch margins.

- 1, Write a paragraph about the following: the main character, the other characters, and who's telling the story? (Point of view). Where and when the story takes place?
2. Next paragraph: What is the main problem/conflict in the story? How does the character resolve the problem/conflict? What is the most exciting moment of the story? (Climax)
3. Think about something that happened to the character. How would you have handled the situation? Did you learn a lesson from this story? If so, what was it, and how might you use it in your own life? Use examples from the book with your opinion
4. Next paragraph: What are your impressions of the story? How do you feel about the main character once you finish reading? Do you think something like this could really happen? Why or why not?
