

**Directions to the Herr's
Timberlane Farm from Everett, Breezewood, & Crystal Springs**

From Everett: (14.4 miles – 25 minutes)

Turn Right at 2nd light in Everett and take 26 S out of Everett

Turn Left onto Winding Ridge Rd (SR2020) - 2nd Left after you go through the turnpike underpass

Drive 3 miles and at the Mench intersection, turn Left onto Menchtown Rd. for 2.4 miles

At stop sign, go straight to FOX RUN Rd (T-386) and proceed .8 miles to bottom of hill. Go Straight across to HERR Rd (gravel)

Cross a wooden bridge and go up a hill

At the top of the hill is a white farmhouse and red barn

Take the lane to the RIGHT, behind the red barn, past the garage on the LEFT, to John and Judy's.

From Breezewood:

From the turnpike take route 30 west/Breezewood exit, go to the 3rd stop light and turn left. McDonald's and Breezewood Motel are at this intersection. Go about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile and turn right just before the underpass. The sign will say Mattie 7 miles and there will be a sign about three covered bridges. This road is also state road SR2029. Follow the road via the yellow signs with arrows for about 3 miles. At this point you should pass a cemetery on the left and the Cedar Grove Lutheran Church (a little white church) on the right. At the bottom of this hill as you cross the concrete bridge, there will be a wooden covered bridge on your left. Immediately after crossing the bridge turn right onto Memorial Church Road. Continue on Memorial Church Road and after the stop sign there will be a cemetery on

your right. Past the cemetery, come to a stop sign and go straight on too a blacktopped chipped road. This is Fox Run Road, (T-386) - the sign has been twisted! Continue on this road to the bottom of the hill- 1.4 miles. At the bottom of the hill is a fallen down barn to your left. Continue across the road on to a gravel road - Herr Road; across the small wooden bridge. On this gravel road will be the Burkett lane to the left and a house to the right. At the top of the hill is a white clapboard farmhouse and red barn. Take the lane behind the barn down to the garage and the new house.

Just remember on the way back; do not turn left after the cemetery and follow, what becomes Menchtown Road. Instead go straight following Memorial Church Road to the very bottom of the hill. Upon making a left you will cross the concrete bridge with the wooden bridge to the right. Continue on this road, over the turnpike, under the turnpike; too the "T". Turn left and you are headed for Breezewood.

From Crystal Springs

If you are coming from Maryland take Crystal Springs (exit 151) from route 70. Turn right at the stop sign, proceed under the underpass and then turn right towards Gapsville; pass the campground and then take the 1st left onto Oak Grove Road (1.4 miles); go right at the "y" onto Brush Creek Road (1.4 miles). At the top of the hill make a left onto East Mattie Road for 9/10 of a mile; turn right on Iron Bridge Road; turn left on Fox Run Road (2nd left); got to the bottom of the hill, cross the hard road and go straight onto Herr Road(gravel road). Go across the wooden bridge. Stay on this road (our neighbor's lane goes up the hill toward the east) and go straight to the top of the hill; you will pass a white clapboard farmhouse and red barn. Turn right onto lane behind the barn.
