Potted Plant Show

1. Exhibitors must reside within the Southwest District.

1st

- 2. ALL entries must be made on-line. Entry tags will **NOT** be printed at fairgrounds.
- 3. All entries must have been in exhibitor's possession at least 3 months.
- 4. The containers in which the plant is grown in will not be judged but must be clean and presentable.
- 5. All hanging baskets must be equipped with rings and hooks for hanging. Total length not to exceed 5 feet.
- 6. If plants are too large to be moved easily by show committee, they will not be accepted.
- 7. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded. Places will be awarded as follows: 2nd

Best of Show 3rd

8. All classes will have Junior and Senior divisions. Each plant will be marked to distinguish Junior and Senior entries. Junior exhibitors are those currently in grades 1-12.

Cut Flower Show

- 1. Exhibitors must reside within the Southwest District.
- 2. ALL entries must be made on-line. Entry tags will <u>NOT</u> be printed at fairgrounds.
- 3. Southwest Arkansas District Fair will furnish containers for exhibits.
- 4. Foliage should have all dust removed. Leaf shine spray is not allowed.
- 5. Exhibitors must furnish the name of the flower.
- 6. Only one entry per exhibitor per class.
- 7. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - 1st 2nd 3rd Best of Show
