Student Suspension or Expulsion

The law provides for the suspension and expulsion of students from school attendance. However, the Northwest Wyoming Board of Cooperative Educational Services is not the legal district of residence and therefore cannot suspend or expel a student. The Administrative Director will involve authorities of the member district of residence and/or Department of Family Services. The direction of these authorities and the IEP process will be followed for appropriate placement decisions for students.

Should a student, in the opinion of the Administrative Director, need to be removed from attendance at NWBOCES for reasons specified by law, parents/guardian, home district, DFS (if involved) shall be notified immediately.

Wyoming School Code - 21-4-305 and 21-4-306 and PL 94-142 regulation will prevail in any and all suspension from NWBOCES.
