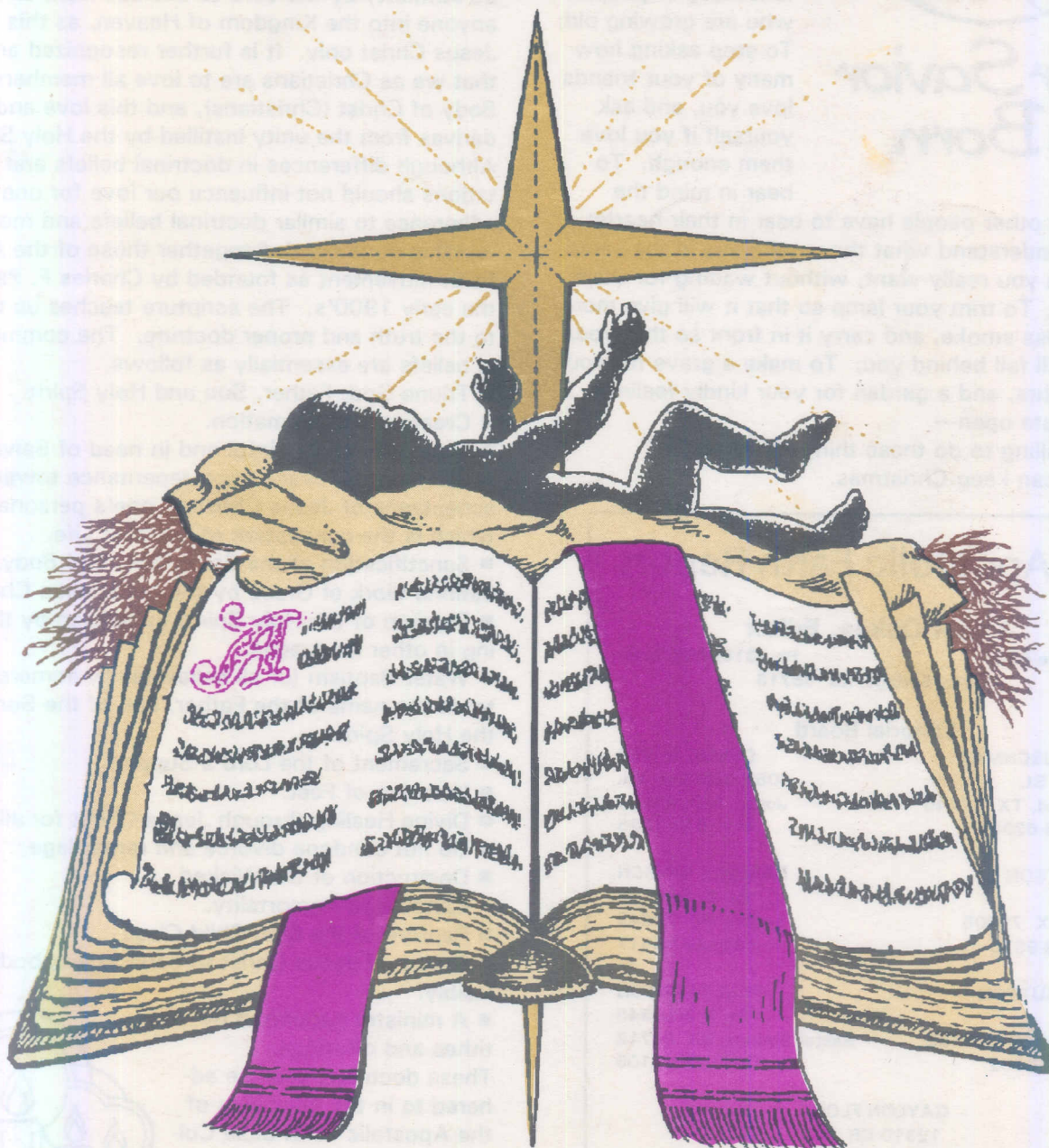

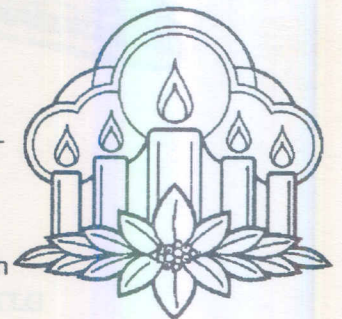

## BY LAWS OF THE Apostolic Faith Bible College, Inc. ARTICLE VII

### Doctrine

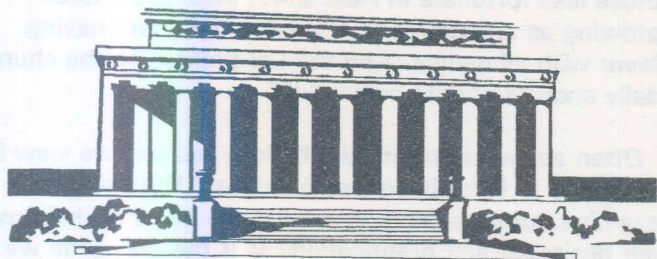
It is recognized that the true church of Jesus Christ consists of all believers who believe in the saving grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and who have accepted Him as their personal Savior. It is recognized and agreed that no organization or man has been granted authority by the Lord to exclude from or accept anyone into the Kingdom of Heaven, as this is done by Jesus Christ only. It is further recognized and agreed that we as Christians are to love all members of the Body of Christ (Christians), and this love and fellowship derives from the unity instilled by the Holy Spirit. Although differences in doctrinal beliefs and interpretations should not influence our love for one another, adherence to similar doctrinal beliefs and modes of worship have bonded together those of the Apostolic Faith Movement as founded by Charles F. Parham in the early 1900's. The scripture teaches us to adhere to the truth and proper doctrine. The common doctrinal beliefs are essentially as follows.

- Triune God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
  - Creation and Formation.
  - Man is basically sinful and in need of Salvation.
  - Salvation by Grace upon repentance toward God and acceptance of Jesus Christ as one's personal Savior, which is the conception of Spiritual Life.
  - Sanctification of the Spirit, Soul and Body, A second definite work of Grace by the Lord Jesus Christ.
  - Baptism of the Holy Spirit; evidenced by the speaking in other languages.
  - Water Baptism (of all believers) by immersion in water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
  - Sacrament of the Lord's Supper.
  - Washing of Feet.
  - Divine Healing through Jesus Christ for all believers.
  - Do not condone divorce and remarriage.
  - Destruction of the Wicked
  - Conditional Immortality.
  - Rapture of the Man Child Class.
  - Return of Jesus Christ to earth again; bodily and visibly.
  - A ministry supported by tithes and offerings.
- These doctrines shall be adhered to in the teachings of the Apostolic Faith Bible College, which in addition to other doctrinal teaching approved by the Board from time to time if they are not in consistent with the above listed basic doctrines.

## 'Tis The Season! W.W.J.D?

It is becoming more frequent, even in America's smaller cities and towns, to observe people holding a sign that says something to the effect of, "will work for food". Never are these people dressed nice or even neat for that matter. And another thing, if cleanliness is next to Godliness then these people can't forget it! W.-W.J.D? (*Editor's Note: W.W.J.D. means What Would Jesus Do*)

How does it make one feel when they encounter this type of situation? Are they compassionate, embarrassed, angered? The odds are, one becomes just a little bit uncomfortable when around those less providential, perhaps even questioning whether the situation is genuine or simply a scam. All sorts of questions spin through one's thoughts. Does man simply lean to his instincts and emotions failing to consider those less fortunate, having no understanding of what they may have gone through in arriving to their present situation? W.W.J.D?

Could these be the poor and the strangers of Leviticus 23:22? But that would mean we are to accept these for who they are, even accepting a certain responsibility for them. Showing an attitude of friendliness, Matthew 5:16 says, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven". W.W.J.D?

It is fitting for this summons to be centered between the Feast of Shabuot and Rosh Hashana. Pentecost, having allowed the Spirit of God to fill man's life, if man will allow, will give one the spirit of love, kindness and compassion. This in turn reflects Christ in us. It is a time of work, setting one's own self aside to consider a poor stranger. It will take a person out of their comfort zone. Paul wrote of the importance of love in 1 Corinthians 13:13, "And now abideth faith, hope, charity (love), these three; but the greatest of these is charity (love)." And Rosh Hashana, the sounding of the trumpet, being as a deadline to have completed that which one's been called to do. W.W.J.D?

There will always be the question of a person's motives. But as long as help is provided with no strings attached and with a pure heart, one knows by faith and will have the peace of God in their heart. Phillipians 4:7, "And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your heart and minds through Jesus Christ." "I am the Lord your God" is emphasized 16 times in the 19th chapter of Leviticus. This alone should be motive enough for us to do what we feel Jesus would have us do.

One can see the benefits of obedience in helping those less fortunate in Acts 2:47, with the church growing as an end result. "Praising God, and having favor with all people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved?"

Often as we enter into the holiday season we view it as a time to help those less fortunate. We need to examine our reasoning, is it from the heart or perhaps our desire for self gratification? Is it the only time we think about them or are we reaching out year round? One should recognize that this season of giving, between Pentecost and Rosh Hashana, Leviticus 23:22, must continue. W.W.J.D?

Jesus never asked us to do anything He wouldn't or hadn't done. We have His commission in Matthew 28:18 - 20; Mark 16:15 and Luke 24:47.

On any given day, What Would Jesus Do? On any given day what would you do? As a Christian, shouldn't they be the same? W.W. J. D?

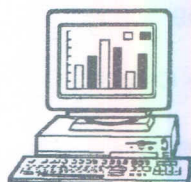

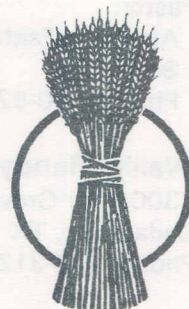

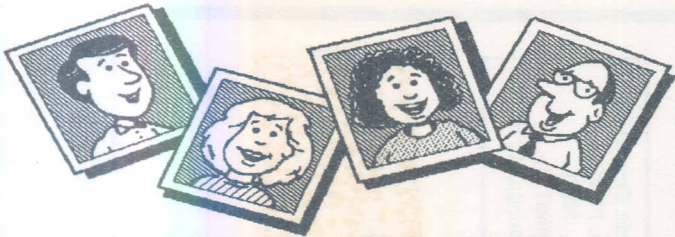
One day he questioned a neighbor, "What is the reason your yield is better than mine? Our land is about the same, but your oats yield doubles mine."
