

Margaret McGregor, age 103, of Bad Axe, passed away on Tuesday, May 29, 2018 at McLaren Thumb Region in Bad Axe.

Margaret was born on September 23, 1914 in Woodstock, Ontario, Canada, daughter of the late Sydney Walter and Ada (Payne) Killing.

She married Capt. Robert McGregor at the National Cathedral in Washington, D.C. in November 1944. He preceded her in death in October 1984.
