Liturgy



Today, we welcome **Savannah Sumat** through Baptism, into the family of God. May the Spirit she receives, guide her as she grows in greater understanding of her faith and holiness!



This is the third Sunday of the Easter Season and the joy of Easter continues to part of the liturgical celebrations. The gospels for the Easter Season are taken from the Gospel of John and generally describe the events following the Resurrection. In today's gospel Jesus appears to his disciples for the third time and shares a meal with them. We recall that Jesus appeared to Mary of Magdala, then to all his disciples except Thomas and finally to Thomas and the disciples. We read that the disciples, led by Peter, returned to their work as fishermen and Jesus came among them. John's Gospel seems to conclude with a reference to other signs that Jesus gave after his Resurrection which are not recorded.

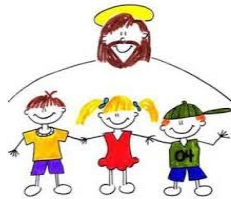


This is also the first Sunday of the month of May, the month traditionally devoted to honouring Mary as the Mother of Jesus. Each month the Holy Father asks for our prayers for a specific intention. During May this year the Pope asks "that the Church in Africa, through the commitment of its members, may be the seed of unity among her peoples and a sign of hope for this continent."

The Rosary prayer has always been part of our May devotions to Mary.

We gather as a community each Wednesday morning following morning Mass to pray for all our families and to give thanks for the blessings, we have received during this Easter Season. We will also remember the special intention of Pope Francis.
