Bill No. 24-12 An Ordinance authorizing and providing a contract between the City of Fair Grove, Missouri (Hereinafter sometimes called "The City") and The Empire District Electric Company (Hereinafter sometimes called "The Company"), its successors or assigns, for electric service and equipment to light the City's streets, alleys, and public ways, electric service for light and power for the City's parks, other properties and public places, for a term of 2 years, and specifying the prices to be paid for such lighting and power service, and the terms and conditions of such contract; and in consideration of Company's covenants and obligations contained herein and Company's acceptance of the terms and conditions contained herein for the establishment, operation and maintenance of the Company's facilities within the City; except providing further that nothing herein shall prohibit the City from lawfully collecting an occupation tax, license tax, motor vehicle license fees and any ad valorem tax on the Company's real estate and personal property.
