SIKKEMA SENSATIONAL IN MATCH PLAY, WINS 4th TITLE HESS DOMINANT IN WINNING FOR 4th TIME

SIKKEMA ROLLS OVER THE COMPETITION IN MATCH PLAY TO GRAB TITLE # 4

Seth Sikkema became a 4-time tour champion with a convincing performance at this month's event, hosted at Cadillac XBC in Waterloo, Iowa. The powerful 2-hander from Fulton, Illinois used his speed – as well as precision – craft a well-earned victory on a tricky lane condition that flummoxed most of the competitors.

This month's champ qualified 4th at +14, but immediately served notice of his intentions by cranking out a huge 290 – the day's highest game – to begin match play. Sikkema was the only finalist who figured out the challenging conditions. Not only was he the only finalist to average 200 – he averaged a very impressive 220 for his 8 matches, posting 6 wins against just 2 losses. Sikkema grabbed the lead early in match play, and continued to pull away throughout the finals. It all added up to a 187-pin margin of victory.

This month, Sikkema became just the 29th player in boy's division history to rack up 15 career match play finals.

For his 16 games, the champion averaged 210.37. He took home the championship plaque and a \$300 scholarship for the 4th tour championship of his career. Congratulations, Seth!

2-TIME CHAMP SOLONKA GRABS RUNNER-UP FINISH

Dakota Solonka continues to make his farewell GISBT campaign a successful one. In August, the cranker secured his 2nd tour title in Cedar Rapids, and this month, he advanced to the 10th match play finals of his career. Last season, he finished runner-up in the Bowler of the Year race.

The right-hander from Indianapolis, Indiana rolled to a runner-up finish at this month's event. With his efforts, he hauled in a \$200 scholarship as well.

WOLF TAKES 3rd

Avery Wolf earned a \$175 scholarship by virtue of his 3rd place showing; the smooth-stroking southpaw from Skokie, Illinois was appearing in his 6th match play finals. This month, he was one of 2 left-handers to qualify for the finals.

QUALIFYING LEADER DENTON FINISHES 4th

Zack Denton led the boy's field after qualifying by averaging 209.12 for his 8 games. Like the majority of finalists, the right-hander from Waverly, lowa struggled during match play to find the range, and he ultimately wound up in 4th place. He took home a \$150 scholarship for his efforts.

WEBER ROLLS TO 5th PLACE

Dalton Weber was this month's 5th place finisher. The right-hander from Camanche, Iowa was one of 2 first-time finalists this month, and he hauled in a \$125 scholarship for his breakthrough performance.

PAST CHAMP MILLER NABS 6th

Evan Miller, a past tour champion, was this month's 6th place finisher. The talented right-hander from Sioux Falls, South Dakota earned a \$110 scholarship for his day's work – the 8th match play finals appearance of his career.

ROTH RETURNS TO FINALS, TAKES 7th

Corey Roth returned to the finals for the 2nd time in his promising career. One of three 2-handers in this month's match play finals, Roth earned a \$100 scholarship for his finish. Roth made his match play debut with a 6th place showing at last season's February tour stop in Moline, Illinois.

CUTSFORTH 8th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT

Thomas Cutsforth rounded out this month's match play finals field. The stocky southpaw from Ottumwa, lowa was making his match play debut, and he took home a \$90 scholarship for his performance.

This month's high game out of the money was awarded to Jacob Miner, who rolled a nice 249 in his qualifying round to secure the \$55 scholarship.

HESS SETS TORID PACE IN QUALIFYING, SECURES 4th TOUR VICTORY

Megan Hess put on a sensational clinic during her qualifying round this month, and her shotmaking skills enabled her to carry a whopping 259-pin lead into the match play finals. From there, it seemed to be all academic, as she would go on to capture her 4th Greater lowa title; the final margin of victory was 214 pins.

Hess' amazing qualifying performance computed to a 219.50 average for her 8 games, and was the talk of the event – one the finest rounds of her young career. The scoring pace slowed considerably during the finals, but her lead was so large, and the conditions were so difficult, that the other finalists couldn't gain any traction. Hess posted a 3-3 match play ledger, and her final 14-game average was 203. She earned a \$225 scholarship, as well as the championship plaque. Congratulations, Megan!

SWANK'S 258 CLOSING LINE EARNS RUNNER-UP FINISH

Christin Swank parlayed an impressive closing 258 into a runner-up finish at this month's tour stop. Swank now owns a quartet of runner-up finishes to go along with her 4 tour titles, and this month marked the 23rd match play finals of her illustrious career.

MAGSAM IN CAREER FORM WITH 3rd PLACE SHOWING

It's hard to consider Keira Magsam a tour veteran at age 14 – but it's true. The talented right-hander from Gretna, Nebraska made her GISBT debut more than 4 years ago – at age 10. And ever since, strong superlatives have been tossed about regarding her successful future on tour, and this month, she posted her strongest showing ever on tour – a 3rd place finish that garnered her a \$130 scholarship.

Exactly a year ago – in October 2019, Magsam enjoyed a breakthrough finish with her first-ever match play finals appearance. That came at C.R.B.C. in Cedar Rapids, and the result was a 6th place finish. This month, she easily bested that showing with her 3rd place mark. And those prognostications seem to be coming true for the 14 year-old tour veteran.

MOORE PLACES 4th

Rachel Moore is another of the tour's rising stars – and another player that has to be considered a tour veteran despite being just 15 years old. The right-hander from Keokuk, Iowa finish 4th this month, adding a \$110 paycheck to her account. This was the 6th match play finals of her career.

3-TIME CHAMP NELSON TAKES 5th

Addy Nelson, a 3-time tour winner, was this month's 5th place finisher. The Gregory, South Dakota native was appearing in her 9th match play finals, and she won a \$100 scholarship for her finish.

WARKEL FINISHES 6th

Anna Warkel rounded out this month's girls finals field; she finished 6th, earning a \$90 scholarship. The talented right-hander from Cedar Rapids, Iowa was returning to the finals for the 3rd time in her blossoming career.

Newcomer Kelsey Freeman, in her GISBT debut, completed her qualifying round with a 206, and that was high enough for the Rock Island, Illinois resident to claim this month's \$55 high game out of the money scholarship.
