


Born & raised in metro Atlanta. Attended Spring Street Elementary, Westminster, Phillips Academy / Andover, and graduated from Grady High School 1959.


Continuing Legal Education (CLE) is required for all lawyers, 12 hours per year; often I participate in 3 times as much bar sponsored legal study as is required.
