- Practical Self-defense Techniques

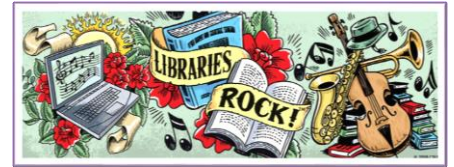
