PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Be respectful to **all** coaches, officials and volunteers. And be respectful to **all** players, both team mates and opposition, and treat them as you would like to be treated.
- Accept victory and defeat with dignity and grace.
- Play where you are asked and try your best in that position for the good of the team.
- Make every effort to develop your own skills, tactics and fitness with the aim of reaching your full potential . Practice the skills learned in training and attempt to apply them within matches.
- At the end of matches, shake hands, give three cheers, thank the umpires, thank refreshment providers and thank your opponents.
- Show commitment. Players should endeavour to always make themselves available for training and matches, so as not to let their team mates down.
- Behave safely and sensibly, and do not use bad language.
- Share any concerns you have with your Year Group Manager or coach, and ask questions if you do not understand. Concerns cannot be dealt with if they are not voiced.
- Do not make negative reference to any Ashtead All Stars Netball Club activity, official, player or parent on the internet.

Team members sticking to the Code of Conduct will ensure that everyone will get the most fun and enjoyment out of their netball, and it will help promote Ashtead All Stars, making it a club to be proud of.
