ATTENDANCE: Excused members included Tommy Mills, Danny Scott, Angie Hydrick, Diane Boulware, Al Stevens, Alyssa Stevens

ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The agenda for October was adopted with the following correction: Pastor's report should read Pastor Gina, not Pastor Anderson

ADOPTION OF MINUTES: The minutes for the September council meeting were accepted. The minutes for the Congregational meeting were accepted with the correction of spelling for Pastor Gina Metze.

REPORTS:

Pastor Gina gave a report for October.

Emily Morris, Treasurer, presented a report for August and September as well as a Quarterly report.

Annette Price, Financial Secretary, submitted a report for September as well as a Quarterly and Year to Date report.

BOARD/COMMITTEE REPORTS/BUSINESS:

- 1. Property: Based on a recommendation from the Finance committee, window repairs will be put on hold until analysis of HVAC system is complete.
- 2. Finance: Recommendation: Finance recommends we make the final synodical payment of \$3,000 to meet our \$12,000 commitment for the year. Passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Farming Church: Pastor Gina and Terry will attend coaching session this week. Terry will send out link to the next webinar. We will meet on November 4 after the concert for our next session (approximately 4:30).
- 2. Cemetery: Putting together a team to look at new quote and funds available to see how to move forward.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. 2019 Spending plan was presented and recommendation made to accept the plan. **Passed**
- 2. Nominations for council were made. 4 adults and 1 youth as well as alternates were chosen.
- 3. A request from Oakwood Commons neighborhood was received to use our Fellowship Hall for their annual meeting on November 15 at

- 6:30. Discussion held that this would be a good way to reach out to the community. Pastor Gina agreed to meet them there to greet them and lock/unlock building. **Recommendation made that we waive the non-member fee since this is a good opportunity for outreach. Passed.**
- 4. Stephen Price fund- Recipients are chosen to receive this funding in September and January. Rebekah Swygert was chosen as the recipient.
- 5. Installation service for Pastor Gina will be November 11 at 3:00 pm with a reception following. This is now done as a separate service, and not part of the Sunday morning Worship service,
- 6. Pastor Gina will attend Convocation October 22-24
- 7. Pastor Gina has set up an email that will link directly to the calendar on the website. All are free to use this new email: wearemthermon@gmail.com
- 8. Congregational meeting schedule:

November 18: Congregational meeting after Worship service
