

A virtual meeting of **North Wraxall Parish Council** took place on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020. The following members participated:

**Prior to the meeting Cllr Whitehead introduced himself and gave a brief outline of how Wiltshire Council is coming out of the Covid-19 lockdown having been on a seven day week since 2<sup>nd</sup> March. It is hoped that normal working will resume within the next three to four weeks.**

**The Clerk reported that Cllrs King and Horrocks-Taylor had both resigned from the Parish Council and that Wiltshire Council had been notified . Official notices would be displayed on receipt. Should an election not be called the Parish Council following the legally required timeframe would then advertise the two vacancies for co-opted members.**

76.3 The Clerk reported that an email had been received from a North Wraxall parishioner requesting the speed limit in North Wraxall be reduced to 20mph in line with Upper Wraxall. This will be an item on the September agenda, however, it was pointed out by the chairman that the reduction from 30mph to 20mph would most probably not be considered as essential by WC, the lowering in Upper Wraxall having been from 60mph.
