### Why Lie?

When the apostle Paul wrote to Titus (whom he had left in Crete), concerning the qualifications of an elder, he emphasized the importance of the office because "there are many unruly men, vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision, whose mouths must be stopped; men who overthrow whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake. One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, idle gluttons. This testimony is true" (Titus 1:10-13): "This character of the Cretans is abundantly sustained by the examples adduced by Wetstein. To be a Cretan, became synonymous with being a liar, in the same way as to be a Corinthian, became synonymous with living a licentious life" (Albert Barnes): as was testified by "One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, idle gluttons" (ibid).

When addressing the evangelist Timothy, he warned him saying, "But evil men and impostors shall wax worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived" (2 Tim. 3:13).
