

Jesus was brought to the temple where Simeon was. Simeon held Jesus and said that Jesus would be a light to a world, and a sword would pierce Mary's heart/soul. It's a bittersweet thing to say. It's why the presentation of the Lord is considered the first sorry of the 7 sorrows of Mary, but it is also the 4th joyful mystery of the rosary!

There are many ways you can celebrate Candlemas. You can go to mass of course, and pray the rosary and say the Joyful mysteries. You could even make a craft! One craft you could do is take a clear plastic punch cup and cut squares of tissue paper. Using modge-podge or glue you can decorate the cup with the tissue to make it look like stained glass. Put a battery-powered tea light in it and together as a family sing 'This little light of mine'! It's a fun activity that helps remind us how Jesus is the light of the world.


OCS Parish Sponsorship




Palm Branches
