First Lesson Isaiah 54:13-17 <u>13</u> All your children shall be taught by the LORD, and great shall be the peace of your children. <u>14</u> In righteousness you shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you. <u>15</u> If anyone stirs up strife, it is not from me; whoever stirs up strife with you shall fall because of you. <u>16</u> Behold, I have created the smith who blows the fire of coals and produces a weapon for its purpose. I have also created the ravager to destroy; <u>17</u> no weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed, and you shall confute every tongue that rises against you in judgment. <u>Second Lesson</u> 1 Corinthians 1:18-25 <u>18</u> For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.<u>19</u> For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart."<u>20</u> Where is the one who is wise?
