Dear Partners:


Eph. 6:13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to WITHSTAND in the evil day, an having done all, to stand..



**Our son John and granddaughter Corin were both back and participated in medical, Maasai school evangelism, children's ministry and Maasai village ministry.**



## MATHARE CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTRE (MCDC)


On the road to Momma Jane's and MCDC in Mathare Valley



This is the new (November 2010) MCDC boy's dormitory building which Jane calls her rescue centre. There are 19 boys that call this their home. Most are orphans that were living on the streets of Mathare Valley in Nairobi eating out of the trash.

MIA partners in Arizona donated gift packages for each boy consisting of: boxer shorts, T-shirts, deodorant bars, rubber balls and a new harmonica with instruction book.



At the new Dandora campus construction is continuing on the second floor of the Kitchen-Dining hall building. This floor will have a large sanctuary/chapel plus some smaller Offices.

Ruby and I can't thank you enough for partnering with Mercy In Action. You are changing the lives of countless Maasai in the bush and of 865 street kids at MCDC. God bless each and every one of you for your sacrifice.

## **MINISTRY NEEDS**

- 1) **Dormitory expenses run about \$40.00 per month for each of the 19 boys and 24 girls. Jane has enough money to carry her through November 2011 so she needs your help on this one.**
- 2) **There are now 865 kids in MCDC of which approximately 250 still need sponsors at \$25.00 per month K-8th grade and \$35.00 per month 9-12th grade. Please help us pass the word and refer others to our new web site. ([www.mercyinactionintl.org](http://www.mercyinactionintl.org))**
- 3) **The drought in Kenya has caused a severe shortage of food to the extent many things are rationed in Nairobi and prices are double. Pray Jane can find and buy sufficient amounts of food for all the kids at MCDC.**
